“ From the Beginning of Creation, Part 1” Mark 10:1-12 ESV

- 1 And he left there and went to the region of Judea and beyond the Jordan, and crowds gathered to him again. And again, as was his custom, he taught them.
- 2 And Pharisees came up and in order to test him asked, “Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?”
- 3 He answered them, “What did Moses command you?”
- 4 They said, “Moses allowed a man to write a certificate of divorce and to send her away.”
- 5 And Jesus said to them, “Because of your hardness of heart he wrote you this commandment.
- 6 But from the beginning of creation, ‘God made them male and female.’
- 7 ‘Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife,
- 8 and the two shall become one flesh.’ So they are no longer two but one flesh.
- 9 What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.”
- 10 And in the house the disciples asked him again about this matter.
- 11 And he said to them, “Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her,
- 12 and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery.”

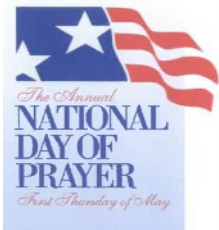

According to the Jewish Calendar Pentecost / Shavuot 2021 will begin on the evening of Sunday, May 16th. All of the spring feasts of Israel have their beginnings in the Hebrew Scriptures and are fulfilled in the New Testament. Passover was fulfilled in the death of Jesus, the Feast of First Fruits is fulfilled in Jesus' resurrection, and Shavuot — or the Feast of Weeks — was fulfilled in Pentecost. Believers in Jesus celebrate the giving of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, after Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection. The giving of the Holy Spirit was promised by the Messiah (John 14:15–18), the Holy Spirit was poured out on the first Christians during the events recorded in the book of the Acts chapter 2, and this day was also the BIRTHDAY of the church! So think about this, next Sunday, May 9th is Mother's Day and if you count back 10 days from Pentecost, you get May 6th. That is about the time Yeshua (Jesus) would have ascended to heaven blessing His disciples as He went up into the clouds. *"Jesus said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight."* (Acts 1:7-9) So, Jesus's mother must have had a bittersweet Mothers Day because she knew her Son was alive and exalted but unseen!
