What Is Tisha B'Av? The saddest date of the Jewish Year a day of mourning & remembrance

The first catastrophe to happen on the ninth day of the month of Av was the evil report from the spies sent to the promised land. Moses' spies came back from the land with reports of a fruitful place but there were giants there. The majority report won. God's command to take the land was disobeyed and the result was a judgement of 40 years wandering in the desert. Another devastation for the Jewish people was the destruction of Solomon's Temple in 586 BC. "By the rivers of Babylon we sat and wept when we remembered Zion. There on the poplars we hung our harps, for there our captors requested a song, and our tormentors demanded songs of joy: "Sing us a

song of Zion." How can we sing a song of the LORD in a foreign land?" (Psalm 137: 1-4) This incursion of Nebuchadnezzar began a 70 year exile in Babylon. The Second Temple was destroyed 656 years later, in 70 AD with an enormous death toll. Sixty-five years after that, in 135 AD, the Bar Kokhba revolt failed, its leader was killed, and its flagship city, Betar, was destroyed. Then, one year later, Jerusalem itself was burned, the Temple area plowed under by Rome, the name of Jerusalem erased. All these events occurred on Tisha B'Av. In 1290 Edward banished all Jews from England. In 1492, King Ferdinand of Spain signed the Alhambra Decree, setting Tisha B'av as the deadline for all of Spain's Jews to leave the country. The Nazis chose this date in 1942 to send Jews from the ghetto at Warsaw into Treblinka for extermination. The 10th of Av, 1994, a van blew up a Jewish bldg in Argentina - 85 dead 300+ wounded.
