



Frequently Asked Questions

Do you offer payment plans?

Yes! We require a first payment that is applied against your total. The balance is then divided up into equal monthly payments. Last monthly payment is due 30 days prior to the event and all payments are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Do you allow alcohol to be served?

Yes! Only Lambermont's select* approved caterers are allowed to bartend any event.

Where do my guests park?

Our parking lot is equipped with 10 standard parking spaces and 2 handicap parking spaces. Parking is also available on both sides of Grayson Street. The church across Willow Street also allows us to use their parking lot as long as they do not have an event in progress. Security and/or Parking attendants are required for every event. Lambermont will schedule the security and/or parking attendant and on most events, the client will pay for the security and/or parking attendant.

Do you offer tables and chairs?

Yes, Lambermont is furnished with antique furniture that you are welcome to use for your event. Only select packages include tables, chairs and linens. Lambermont has several decorative pieces that are included in several packages and can be added on to others for a fee. Please see Additional Amenities.

Do you have a list of required vendors?

Yes, we have a list of Vendors We Love! Any vendor on our list is highly qualified and a true professional. They meet all of the Lambermont requirements and we trust the 100% with our home, and with our clients. We require a Certificate of Liability Insurance covering \$1,000,000 from all vendors naming Lambermont Events as an additional insured.

What are the noise restrictions?

This area has a decibel restriction. As long as your band or DJ is under 75 decibels there should not be any problems. Ultimately, you could continue the music all night provided that security is still present.

How many people can the inside accommodate?

We can comfortably seat about 50 people inside for dining on the first floor and accommodate about 150 people for a standing cocktail reception. More people can mingle if you choose to open up the porches. We can also hold much smaller wedding ceremonies inside for about 50 standing people. Outside can easily accommodate 300 people for ceremony and reception. NOTE: City and State ordinances may override these occupancy numbers.
