Volunteer of the Month: José Maldonado

Here's an example of one who joins God in His work. I want to highlight volunteer **José Maldonado** who comes in weekly to the field of souls and conducts a Bible study. His housing unit has been opened up to us in the last six months.

In this pod most of the inmates are Hispanic detainees awaiting deportation, but there are others as well. José is bilingual and averages



between 20 to 25 guys. One week he had 11 men respond to the gospel as he shared Christ with them! PTL!!! Lives are held captive by their sin, but Jesus wants to set them free and take them captive to His amazing

love and freedom! Thank you José for your faithful service to work the field of souls at the Polk County Jail.

A captive soul rescued! - Todd Devin

My name is Todd Devin. I was adopted at birth and today I know, and believe God was protecting me from day one. He blessed me with the most loving and caring mother. She was a school teacher who instilled the best morals, values and beliefs to succeed in life. I was raised in church and taught about God and His Son our Savior Jesus Christ. Then high school showed up and I strayed from the path my mom and church showed and taught me. I started running around with the drug crowd and with the first drug I tried

I quit school. I was stealing, lying and running from God as hard and fast as I could. I was fourteen with a lot of hurt and pain. I found myself becoming more and more dishonest especially with the ones who loved me. I was in and out of treatment centers many times. I thought I believed in God, but the fox hole prayers were for all the wrong reasons. I went to prison when I was 26, and was in and out for 28 years. I finally came to the point inside where I had so much pain and hurt with no

I keep in mind the go, say, and do rule. Don't go where you can't go with God. Don't say what you can't say to God. Don't

do what you can't do with God, and you will live with the Spirit in your heart to stay. I wouldn't be where or who I am today without the work of God. I thank God for the Polk County Jail Ministry!
