I started drinking, smoking cigarettes and weed when I was only 11 years old. I was a very rebellious kid, and got into trouble with the law. I started using meth when I was 19 years old, and was stealing from stores to support my habit. That's when I got in bigger trouble with the law, and was in and out of jail a lot. Luckily they were

only misdemeanors, so they were very short stays.

I moved to another state in 2000 because I knew if I didn't

I would've ended up in prison or dead. While I was away I found the Lord and became saved. I loved every minute of it. I attended church every Wednesday and Sunday and raised 3 of my 4 kids with Him in our lives. In 2015 I left my ex husband of 15 years and moved back to Iowa. It didn't take long to fall right back into the street life using meth and alcohol. I was self medicating and wanted to escape from reality. I was in and out of jail again, but this time they were longer stays. One of my girlfriends was attending Bible studies while we were in there and invited me to join her. I declined the first couple of times, and then I thought why not. I'm so glad I decided to attend them.

- Brokenness will continue to be evident in those coming to the Polk County Jail, and they will see their ultimate need for a relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Speaking opportunities about the ministry would be available in local churches.
- Wisdom from God for daily decisions with ministry needs that arise.
