I grew up in Ankeny and by the grace of God, AA and sponsorship I've been sober since 06/22/12. At a young age I did very well at wrestling, so I wanted to go to Iowa and wrestle for Coach Dan Gable. A catch to the dream was in my freshman year of high school a couple of my friends and I got a hold

of some beer. For the first time I got drunk, and instantly fell in love with the effects produced by alcohol. My life did a complete 180. I started drinking and using drugs as much and as fast as I could get my hands on them. I skipped school, soon quit the

wrestling team and started running the streets. I visited the Lutheran Hospital treatment center three separate times. Since I was underage I became a ward of the state under the China Act and placed in a group home. I eventually went to Teen Challenge in Yuma, Arizona. While in Teen Challenge I accepted the Lord Jesus Christ to be my Lord and Savior; although I was not entirely ready to surrender my problem with alcohol and drugs. Over the next 15 years plus I found myself in many institutions, treatment centers, hospital stays, and homeless shelters. In one of my many stays at the Polk County Jail I ran into Chaplain Jerry. He would always come in, greet us with a smile, and a

I like to say I couldn't live the way that I was living, and I couldn't live without the drugs and alcohol. I had hit bottom again so I called a man, asked him to be my sponsor, and said what do I do? He told me to pray to God for help and come to a meeting with him. Over the last 11 years if you would've told me that just getting sober was not enough, I would've run the other direction. I have had to face a lot of fears with the courage that only comes from the Lord. I do that one day at a time by surrendering each and every day saying God, may Your will be done not mine. I continue to work 12 step programs in Recovery, and volunteer my time to go to the place that I used to not be able to come out of, the Jail. I go to church regularly, and am involved in a Bible study. All of these things have a ripple effect in my life. It touches the lives of my family, my

friends and any newcomers that God places in my life. It's only by the grace of God there go I. My prayer is that my story touches the heart of somebody out there who's struggling. If I can do it, so can you. Amen and God bless.
