Kittens are recommended to be adopted in pairs because they benefit from the companionship and interaction of another kitten. **However, it is not a requirement.** While having a playmate can enhance their socialization, emotional development, and help prevent loneliness, kittens do thrive as single pets, especially when they receive plenty of attention, stimulation, and care from their human families.

Adopting a new kitten is an exciting and rewarding experience, but it is important to be prepared. Here is a list of essential things you will need when adopting a new kitten:

- Litter Box and Litter
- Food and Water Dishes
- Kitten Food (wet and dry) Purina wet kitten Fancy Feast and Purina Kitten Chow
- Kitten Bed or Blanket
- Toys and Scratching Posts
- Kitten Carrier
- Grooming Tools

The first thing you should do when you get home is place your kitten in the litter box, which should already have litter in it. Make sure the litter box is in the area where it will be staying. This helps to begin litter box training for your kitten.

All cats/kittens are checked for parasites, snap tested for feline leukemia (FeLV) and feline immunodeficiency virus (FIV), vaccinated for FVRCP and rabies (please check if you received your documents), spayed or neutered, flea treated, vet-checked, and may be microchipped (please inquire about your kitten).
