





GET READY: can get ready for school and	į

ADDITION:

can add up to 10+10; with fluency up to 5+5 (easily + automatically)

BLENDING WORDS:

can blend and segment CVC words (e.g. /d/ /o//g/)

COUNTING

can orally count to 100 (or more!) without skipping any numbers, + skip count by 10s

DIGRAPHS:

can read and write consonant digraphs (2 letters that make 1 sound)

ENDING SOUNDS:

can identify beginning, middle, and ending sounds in words

FINE MOTOR SKILLS:

can safely +
correctly hold
and use a pencil
and scissors

can get ready for school and pack up all belongings independently to go home

HANDWRITING:

can write at least one sentence at a time with proper formation

INDEPENDENCE:

can work, play, and clean up independently in the classroom

JUST RIGHT READING:

can choose and fluently read a "just right" decodable book

KIND:

is kind to others; can share and communicate well with peers

LETTERS:

can produce all letter sounds & recognize all uppercase + lowercase letter names

MINUTES:

can focus and pay attention on something for about 15 minutes (or more!)

NAME RECOGNITION:

can recognize and write their first and last name

OPINIONS:

can respect other friends' opinions and provide their own

PAY ATTENTION:

can quietly pay attention to a teacher or activity at hand

QUESTIONS:

understands and uses question words; can ask and answer auestions

RHYME:

can recognize and produce rhyming words

SUBTRACTION:

can subtract from 10; with fluency from 5 (easily + automatically)

<u>TEEN</u> <u>NUMBERS</u>:

can count, recognize, and understand numbers 11-19

UNDERSTAND DIRECTIONS:

can follow 3 and 4 step directions

VOWELS:

knows that
vowels have
short + long
sounds and can
produce them all

WORK HABITS:

can focus and work on an academic task with minimal distractions or avoidance

EXCITED:

continues to be excited about school and to learn and try new things

YEARLY CALENDAR:

knows the names of months, days of the week, & seasons

ZIPPERS, ETC.:

can use zippers & buttons; can fully get dressed independently (shoelaces is a plus!)


