- 4. Each recipient will be awarded \$1,000.00 at the annual Scholarship Awards event on October 19, 2019. Recipient must be present or forfeit the scholarship award NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. Please submit one letter of recommendation from a college professor and a copy of all your official college transcripts <u>including your Spring 2019 semester grades</u>.
- 6. The application must be received by June 14, 2019.
- 7. A point system of rating will be used. Winners will be notified by August 16, 2019.
- 8. Past recipients of the scholarship award are <u>not</u> eligible to apply a second time.
