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Carl Ghattas

Executive Assistant Director, National Security Branch

Carl Ghattas currently serves as the executive assistant director of the National Security Branch where he leads the FBI's operations and intelligence efforts involving all national security matters, ranging from terrorism to espionage to weapons of mass destruction. Under his leadership, the program will continue to focus on technical innovation, operational agility, and strategic partnerships.

Mr. Ghattas joined the FBI in 1997. Upon graduating from the FBI Academy, he worked counterterrorism investigations in the Washington Field Office. Mr. Ghattas deployed overseas to investigate several major attacks against the United States, including the 1998 bombing of the U.S. Embassy in Nairobi, Kenya; the 2000 attack against the U.S.S. Cole in Aden, Yemen; and the murder of several Americans in Greece by the Greek terrorist group 17 November. Over the course of his 20-year career, the majority of Mr. Ghattas' focuses have been on counterterrorism efforts in the United States and around the world and strategically integrating intelligence and operations to ensure intelligence collection aligns with priority threats. In 2014, he was appointed special agent in charge of the Washington Field Office's counterterrorism program and, most recently, served as the assistant director of the Counterterrorism Division.

Mr. Ghattas has received numerous awards, to include the Attorney General's Award for Distinguished Service and the Exceptional Achievement Medal from the Office of the Director of National Intelligence.

Mr. Ghattas earned a bachelor of arts from Duke University and a Juris Doctor from Washington University.

The Justice Department is blocking Senate investigators from interviewing two top FBI officials who could provide testimony on the firing of former Director James Comey and the handling of the investigation into Hillary Clinton's use of a private email server, according to a letter obtained by The Hill.

Senate Judiciary Chairman Chuck Grassley (R-Iowa) and ranking member Dianne Feinstein (D-Calif.) have repeatedly requested that the two senior bureau officials, Carl Ghattas and James Rybicki, appear for a transcribed interview.

The Justice Department in July declined the committee's request to speak with Rybicki and Ghattas, citing the appointment of Robert Mueller to serve as special counsel in the Russia investigation and "related matters."

Grassley and Feinstein offered to limit the scope of their questions to events that occurred before Comey's dismissal, in an effort to avoid a conflict with the pending Mueller investigation, but the Justice Department has stood by its initial refusal.

Today was different. Carl Ghattas, FBI's Executive Assistant Director for National Security, testified. And aside from totally dodging a Chuck Grassley question about why, according to Rosemary Collyer, FBI waited 11 months before informing the FISA Court about one violation, he was a very informative witness.

Take, for example, a detail he provided in his written testimony (after 34:50) about what FBI obtains in raw form (this may be public in the DIOG that the intercept leaked, but I'm not otherwise aware of this detail). The FBI can only get raw data for selectors "relevant to" full investigations, not preliminary investigations or assessments.

It's important to remember FBI receives a small fraction of the total collection that NSA receives under this program. In fact, the FBI only receives a small percentage of NSA's downstream collection and none of NSA's upstream collection. The reason for this is that the FBI can only request and receive Section 702 collection if the selector — that is, an email address or social media handle, for example — is relevant to a pending full investigation. The FBI cannot receive Section 702 collection during either a preliminary inquiry or an assessment. As a result, although the FBI conducts significantly more US person queries than NSA, those queries are running against a small fraction of the total 702 collection that is acquired by the US government. In other words, when the FBI runs a US person identifier through our database, that query is run against only FBI's 702 collection that's obtained during FBI full investigations and not the total collection maintained by NSA.

This does limit things, though as the FBI likes to say, it has thousands of investigations going at any time, the most emphasized of which (terrorism and counterintelligence) would likely implicate 702 data. Moreover, it raises questions about the foreign intelligence designations made, especially (prior to this year) regarding the data FBI shared in raw form with NCTC. And of course, we all know that the word "relevant to" has ceased to have real limiting meaning.

Also, the FBI may only obtain this information at the Full Investigation level, but it can query it at the assessment level. And today's hearing, like all others, failed to discuss that the FBI uses those queries, in part, to find informants, some of whom may be guilty of nothing beyond doing something that FBI can use to coerce their cooperation.
