I see lots of comments about Lunev and Bridges based on prejudices not based on knowledge or digging for recent factual evidence.

Most people are drawing inferences about "the Russians" but Lunex was quite clearly NOT A RUSSIAN. He was a Soviet intelligence officer who stayed on in the Russian Federation for a year or two in the early part of the Yeltsin regime. He left before the Civil War in 1993. We now know that Yeltsin was a puppet although it is not clear who if anyone really controlled him. The CIA was definitely an organization VERY ACTIVE in Russia at that time trying to consolidate control. We now know that the CIA failed when a group of strong men convince Yeltsin it was in his best interests to hand over the presidency to Vladimir Putin. And we know that Putin MADE RUSSIA GREAT AGAIN through a program of rooting out corruption at all levels of society, measured economic growth, modernising government in an orderly fashion, and perestroika, i.e. rebuilding infrastructure that have been decaying since the mid 1960s. Putin pushed the CIA out and restored Russia's military power, ALWAYS working in Russia's best interests and carefully avoiding international relations based on the old Soviet Comintern concept of a global power.

So, what does Lunev teach us about Russia? Quite simply, nothing. He was not a part of that story. But what does he teach us about the Soviet Communist relations with the USA and other countries. As you know, history is very important to untangling and destroying the cabal's network of criminal conspiracy. And you also know that this work started in earnest in the 1950s. So Lunev has a lot to teach us about that time. It might even extend to identifying some of the Soviet sleeper agents who were either born in the USA or placed here as children and who did not stop their work when the Soviet Union went away. Like some anons mentioned, it might include info on the US prisoners in Hanoi. But it almost certainly will extend to the Chicago group which included Saul Alinsky, several people with contacts to the Rosenbergs, Obama, the Rodham family and others. Victoria Nuland has a strange episode in her youth when she disappeared on board a Soviet fishing trawler for 6 months. How many other such people ended up in high positions in the government?

Some might say that Lunev's revelations could BRIDGE the knowledge gap about how the KGB really impacted the USA before they lost their Moscow Center control in 1991.

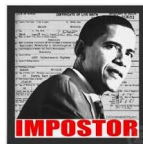

The subcommittee met, pursuant to call, at 10:10 a.m., in room 2118, Rayburn House Office Building, Hon. Curt Weldon (chairman of the subcommittee) presiding.  
OPENING STATEMENT OF HON. CURT WELDON, A REPRESENTATIVE FROM PENNSYLVANIA, CHAIRMAN, MILITARY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT SUBCOMMITTEE.  
Mr. WELDON: The subcommittee will come to order. May I ask everyone to be seated so that we can begin the hearing and bring in our witness.  
This morning the Military Research and Development Subcommittee meets in open session to receive testimony from Col. Stanislav Lunev, formerly of the GRU. Colonel Lunev has written a book, *Through the Eyes of the Enemy*, which makes some startling allegations about ongoing Russian preparations for the war with the United States.

According to Colonel Lunev, "Soviet communist parties are planning that would assassinate U.S. political and military leaders and sabotage key targets in the United States." By using which one portable receiver response, I should note that Colonel Lunev is a protected witness, and so special arrangements have been made at the hearings today to control his identity and provide for his physical security. I would ask members of the audience and the press to please cooperate and refrain from photographing Colonel Lunev's face, should, through some mishap, an opportunity for such a photograph accidentally arise.  
Also, audience and press, please respect the arrangements for Colonel Lunev's physical security by refraining from attempting to approach or interview Colonel Lunev in this forum.


