Help Ukraine 22:

Help Ukraine 22 has been on the ground in-country since March 1, less than a week after the invasion. As people and NGOs were leaving the country, we were becoming fully operational. Our model has been to support existing structures and advocate for them, such as hospitals, women's shelters, and group homes.

We are nearly 100% volunteer across 8 time zones. We only pay those who are Ukrainian or refugees from Ukraine. This leaves our overhead low and targeted impact higher.

By partnering with those already embedded in communities we have been able to strategically implement and monitor impact of our work.
