List of Sample Natural Environment Training (NET) or Incidental Teaching Activities

PLAY WITH WHAT MOTIVATES YOUR CHILD OR LEARNER

- 1. Pretend play with action figures and animals: creating toy sequences and including these toys in your daily routine, i.e., bathing, brushing teeth, eating, etc.
- 2. Cars and Car chase in a ramp or any other furniture in the house
- 3. Building toys such as Lego, model aircrafts, cars, railways, puzzles
- 4. Little People on the Bus while singing Nursery Rhymes like the "Wheels on the Bus", or toy animals in the farm while singing "Old MacDonald".
- 5. Work with actions or verbs like "stop and go", or counting, "1,2,3", while rocking on a horse, or pushing your child in a swing, jumping on a trampoline with your child, hula hoops
- Toys which you can use for all NET skills: Lego, Mr. Potato Head, Bubbles, Play-doh, Silly Putty, wind-up toys, dolls, pretend kitchen sets, or better yet your own real house furniture ⁽²⁾
- 7. Sensory bins and sensory toys
- 8. Musical instruments
- 9. Forts, tents, blankets
- 10. All the fun activities you can make: swimming, cooking, eating or just being silly and fun!
