Note: RPA permits will generally require the pilot to be assisted by a spotter to monitor wildlife and other aircraft.

**Site establishment requirements** – site access (vehicle and/or foot - on/off formed tracks); use of existing or proposed temporary facilities (shelter/toilets); any site clearance (vegetation or soil disturbance) etc?

The extent of assessment will depend on a number of factors including scale of the proposed activity; the potential risk to people, wildlife and property; the potential to impact on visitor experiences, and park management requirements. The applicant may be required to complete a Park Activity Assessment (PAA).*
