

MISSOURI LIVESTOCK ACHIEVEMENT AWARD



General Information

The Missouri Livestock Achievement Award recognizes an individual or organization demonstrating outstanding achievements and distinguished contributions to the livestock industry. Eligible applicants can be producers of livestock, agribusiness personnel, agency personnel, or agriculture educators in the state of Missouri. Other parties who have been long-time supporters of the Missouri livestock industry will also be considered.

The selected applicant will become a member of the Missouri Livestock Symposium Hall of Fame and will be inducted during the Thursday evening program of the Missouri Livestock Symposium.

Selection Process

An appointed selection screening committee will rate the top applications and submit those names to the Missouri Livestock Symposium (MLS) committee. The MLS committee will vote for final approval of the recipient.

Application Deadline:

October 15, 2025.

Wallet size or larger color photo of applicant must accompany the application. A posed head and shoulder print is desired.
