

# HURRICANE PREPARATION LIST

-  Assemble hurricane supplies
-  Clear yard of debris
-  Park car in garage if available
-  Bring garbage cans and grill inside
-  Refill prescription medication
-  Check carbon monoxide monitor batteries
-  Find local radio station to stay informed during and after the hurricane if power / cable / internet is out
-  Secure important documents like birth certificates, passports and insurance policies in a watertight container
-  Take a video of your property and belongings in case of future insurance claim
-  Fill your bathtub with water, which may be needed to flush toilets
-  Cover windows with plywood or shutters if you do not have impact windows
-  Go to a bank or ATM and take out cash for use post-hurricane if power is out and you can't pay with cards
-  Let friends or family know where you will be staying during the storm
-  Set your refrigerator and freezer to the coldest setting to keep your food cold longer during a power outage
-  If you have pets, make sure they are vaccinated and you have a record - you will need this to go to a pet-friendly shelter
-  Verify that your contact information is updated on your pet's microchip registration
-  Pre-register for pet-friendly shelter in your area if you plan to evacuate there
-  Fill your car with gas
-  Develop an evacuation plan
-  Trim trees overhanging your roof
-  Charge your phone and external batteries
-  Fill your generator with gas if you have one
-  Clear outside drains, gutters and downspouts
