WHAT TO DO AFTER THE STORM



Never use your generator indoors, or within 20 ft of an open door, window, vent to your home



Never use grills and camp stoves indoors or within 20 ft of an open door, window or vent to your home



Stay out of floodwater - it can harbor disease, downed powerlines and wildlife



Never use a wet electrical device



If power is out, use flashlights and lanterns instead of candles



Stay away from downed powerlines. Report to the electrical company



Do not enter damaged buildings until authorities determine it is safe



Do not consume perishable food that has gone bad during the power outage



Stay tuned to local news/radio regarding unsafe water and issues with sewage pumping stations



In case of damage to your home, take photos and start a claim with your insurance company as soon as possible



Take reasonable actions to protect your property from further damage



Check on your neighbors
