Artists are responsible for details and process of selling their work. No technical or sales support will be provided by Hughes Family Tribute Center. For 2026, all entry fees are waived. Artists are expected to set their own pricing and 100 percent of the sales will go to the artists.

Restrictions

The Día de los Muertos Celebración is a family-friendly event. **No nude images will be displayed.** The organizers reserve the right to decline to display any work deemed inappropriate for the occasion.

Security Waiver

The Crown Hill Mausoleum will be locked when not open for specified exhibition days and times. The artist assumes all risk in having his or her work on display during the Día de los Muertos Celebración. None of the other parties involved assume any risk for art on display during the event. A signed security waiver will be required from each participating artist.
