## MEMBERSHIP CHECKLIST



Did you know when someone joins your PTA they have also become part of Missouri and National PTA? Their voice has been added to the millions of other PTA members who actively advocate for ALL children.

Membership is an ongoing process and recruitment should continue year-round. Now is the time to regroup and think about kicking off a new membership drive for the new year. Also, think about making signing up easier by switching to an online platform. Here is a great article from Missouri PTA about Membership basics.

After collecting membership dues, don't forget to then forward payment on to MOPTA, due can be paid online here or you can print out the form and

mail them in.

#### IS YOUR PTA UNIT IN GOOD STANDING?

What does it mean to be a PTA Unit in Good Standing and why is it important? First of all, a PTA unit is essentially a non-profit business and must adhere to certain rules; being in good standing shows that your unit is being completely transparent and open to your members and following said rules. Also, being in good standing means that your unit can take advantage of all benefits available from state and

national PTA (such as grant opportunities). Here is a listing of the Good Standing criteria:

- •submits membership dues to Missouri PTA (see article at left for more info and links).
- •turns in Year-end Financial Review and Report to MOPTA by 12/1 of each year. <u>Link to</u> <u>Financial Review Form; link to</u> <u>PTA unit general finance article.</u>
- IS YOUR PTA A UNIT IN GOOD STANDING?
- •Files IRS 990N e-postcard by due date and submits proof of filing to MOPTA by 12/1. <u>Link to file e-postcard</u>.
- •Submits officer names/contact info to MOPTA by March 31st. Link to submit officer names.
- •Has by-laws updated and approved every 3 years according to MOPTA procedures.

The good news is that Good Standing status can be achieved at anytime, even if due dates have been missed.
