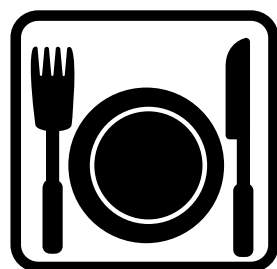
•OUR 2022-2023 THEME•

Table Decorating Guidelines

- **DO** bring your own tablecloths, napkins and decorations - PTA Council does not provide them (table blocks are sets of three 8' tables, seating 24).
- **DO** bring snacks and beverages if you like (no alcohol).
- **DON'T** exceed the height of 14" with your decorations and **DO NOT** have any balloons or lit candles. Any of these will result in disqualification from the table decorating contest.
- **DO** provide a corsage or boutonniere for your Teacher and/or Support Staff of the year
