BYLAWS UPDATE

In October the Missouri PTA approved a new mandatory bylaw update. This new section allows for all Units and Councils to hold electronic meetings for ALL meetings. The only requirement is that every attendee must be able to hear, comment and vote simultaneously with all other attendees. Simply put, every PTA Unit has the ability to hold general membership meetings and conduct business via Zoom, Google Meets, Free Conference Call or similar online platform. There is nothing your Unit needs to do, this is a mandatory change to all bylaws and is automatically in effect for all PTA Units. If you have any questions please contact us.
