## THE HAZELWOOD PTA COUNCIL 39TH ANNUAL RUN/WALK

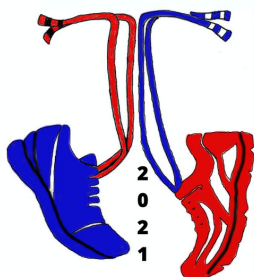
