#### OFFICER ELECTIONS

Believe it or not, now if the time for PTA Units to start planning ahead for the next school year. Units should form their Nominating Committees this month, nominate officers in February and hold elections in March. Per a new by-law put in place by Missouri PTA in October, all units are able to vote in general meetings held electronically (via Zoom, other online platform, teleconference, etc.). The only requirement to applying this bylaw is that every attendee must be able to hear, comment and vote simultaneously with all other attendees. This was an automatic by-law update for all units there is no action needed by your unit to implement this by-law. Exact wording is below:

#### **#ARTICLE XV- ELECTRONIC MEETINGS**

The Board of Directors, Executive Committee, General Membership and any other committees of (insert unit name) may meet by electronic means with the minimum standard being simultaneous aural communication.

Don't forget to report new officers to MOPTA by March 31st via this link. Officers must be reported every year, even if they are the same individuals as the previous year.
