The 6th Global Summit on Spirituality, Religion & Mental Health will be a centralized opportunity for interdisciplinary and international engagement. We invite proposals from chaplains, psychologists, psychiatrists, faith leaders, other clinicians and researchers to chart the future of better integrating spirituality/religion (S/R) in our healthcare systems.

Proposals are invited in the following categories:

- 1) Clinically relevant research/Empirical or theoretical studies exploring S/R variables in mental health, treatment processes, or outcomes:** This includes research advancing understanding of how S/R influence mental disorders, clinical interventions, or spiritually integrated treatments.
- 2) Clinical work informed by research:** Presentations showcasing examples of initiatives that have integrated S/R in clinical practice, public health, and faith settings. This includes successes, lessons learned, and case studies to inform the future development of interventions that have demonstrated relevance to real world settings.
- 3) Theoretical, philosophical, and theological considerations/Contributions that shape frameworks guiding work in S/R and mental health:** May address dominant paradigms or propose alternative models bridging mental health and S/R.
