Displaying active and positive classroom rehearsal skills and teamwork

*Ability to work in small groups

*Completion of classroom activities, homework, and practice logs

*Masterclass, Performance, and Recital etiquette

*Solo performances

*Individual vocal growth

*Positive and supportive attitude

Time Commitments Outside of School:

*Participation in Vocal Tech Recitals during the school year is required

(see Handbook Calendar, page 12 for dates)

*Participation in District Solo/Ensemble Festival <u>is required</u> - Singer must also perform with one of the larger choral groups at District IV Music Performance Assessments to be eligible for Solo/Ensemble Festival

*Attend all vocal concerts including in-school and out-of-school performances

*Multiple practice sessions per week and/or completion of practice logs outside of classtime

Academic Grade Point Requirement:

Students must maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 to be eligible to perform. Vocal Tech members whose grades fall below the required overall average of 2.0 will become grade ineligible and will be ineligible for District Solo/Ensemble Festival. All vocal music students are still required to attend all LaVilla vocal music choral concerts and complete all make-up work.
