As a member of the Vocal Department at LaVilla School of the Arts, the vocal student must:

- Fulfill vocal fees in a timely manner. Fundraisers will be available. (Fees due Oct 31st)
- Attend all AFTER SCHOOL REHEARSALS as scheduled and perform in ALL concerts, community service projects, and school functions as scheduled.
- Obtain a doctor's note for any missed performances.
- Perform in ALL scheduled performances, as well as any future "pop-up" performances.
- Complete all theory work by the dates assigned. (See p. 7 of the Handbook for grade recovery options)
- Maintain a 2.0 Grade Point Average for every 9-week grading period.
- Contribute positively to their individual and group vocal progress and success.

The music theory portion of this class utilizes an online theory website called Music First Classroom. Students are assigned individual usernames & passwords for access (see p.7 of the Vocal Handbook). Weekly theory assignments will be completed through this site. All students have been issued a student laptop by the school for use on online assignments. For families without home internet access, a pass may be obtained from the student's vocal teacher to access the internet before or after school as the teacher's schedule allows. Students must receive a pass from the director at least one day prior, and students must remember to bring their laptop & headphones.

Because this is a Performing Arts School, after school rehearsals may be necessary. Failure to attend rehearsals or any performance without prior approval from the director, or failure to maintain overall grade requirements, may result in the student's grade being lowered or a transfer to a chorus requiring less out-of-class commitments. Students removed from an advanced-level performing chorus (Chorus 3 or Chorus 4) will lose their place in that performance chorus for the remainder of the school year.

To create the kind of chorus these vocal music students want and deserve, rehearsal discipline will be strictly enforced. Please consider the above explanation carefully. If you feel you and your child cannot uphold this serious commitment, please do not subject anyone to the embarrassment or inconvenience of having to be transferred to a group requiring less commitment during the quarter. Please understand that each chorus at LaVilla receives the same quality and level of teaching.
