Vendor Rules and Regulations

Event Schedule:

Event hours are Friday, June 14, 2019, 6 pm - Sunday, June 16, 2019, 2 pm. Setup will take place Friday, June 14, from 8 am to 5:30 pm. Breakdown will begin at 2 pm on Sunday, June 16, 2019 and **must** be completed by 4 pm on Sunday, June 16, 2019.

NOTE: No vehicles will be allowed into the event area while the event is going on except by permission from event staff. ALL VENDOR VEHICLE MOVEMENT WITHIN THE EVENT AREA WHILE THE EVENT IS GOING ON MUST BE ESCORTED BY AN EVENT ORGANIZER! NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

Check - In:

All vendors must sign in at the Vendor Sign-in tent located at the Speedway. This is where vendors will receive space assignments and hospitality packets. Space assignments will **not** be given out prior to the event. Special requests for locations cannot be guaranteed and are based on availability and layout.

Security:

The speedway will remain open throughout the event. Vendors may wish to leave their booths overnight. In doing so, vendor acknowledges that Hog Happenin' Foundation, Inc. and Hickory Motor Speedway, nor any partnering agencies will be held responsible for damage to or loss of goods.

Restrooms:

Public restroom facilities will be located throughout the event area.

Pets:

No pets are allowed in the event area.

Refunds:

We reserve the right to deny any application. If your application is not accepted, your application fees will be refunded. **Refunds will not be given to vendors who cancel their registration after Wednesday, May 1, 2019.**

Inclement Weather:

This event will go on rain or shine; however, if Hog Happenin' Foundation, Inc. dictate cancellation of the event due to severe weather, Hog Happenin' Foundation, Inc nor any partnering agencies will be bound to reschedule the event, nor will the aforementioned entities be bound to reimburse entry fees.

Electrical Power:

Electrical power is available for a fee of \$20. If you have already submitted your application and did not request electrical power, you may be able to purchase it upon arrival. It is recommended that you bring a 100 ft. extension cord for power. Another option for electrical power would be to bring a QUIET generator. Loud generators will not be allowed and violators will be asked to leave.

Vendors Insurance

Vendors are asked to please provide your own Vendor insurance. As an exhibitor or vendor, specialty vendor insurance can help protect you against lawsuits. Your business may be protected against bodily injury and property damage claims that may arise from operations, premises, products, completed operations, advertising or personal injuries. Products and completed operations coverage includes all bodily injury and property damage to a third party that occurs after your product or work leaves your possession. For more information please contact the insurance company of your choice. The organizers may ask you to provide a copy of your Vendor Insurance information.

Parking:

Vehicles are not allowed within the event area unless pre-approved by the Hog Happenin' Foundation, Inc. Parking is available OUTSIDE of the event area.

All vendors are responsible for providing their own equipment; example: tents, tables, etc.

IMPORTANT - Please keep in mind the organizer of this event does NOT own the property where the event is held. We ask that you take all of your waste and belongings back home with you and leave the site as it was when you arrived.

Please retain this copy of your records.
