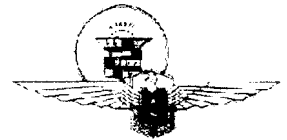

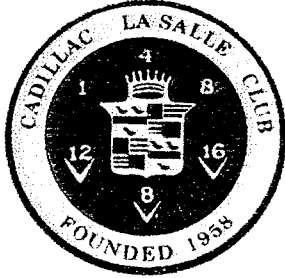

## **MIRACLE LEATHER CLEANING AND REVITALIZING PRODUCT**

About two months ago, I purchased my first Cadillac – a 1976 Fleetwood with about 20K miles on it. The car is in great shape, but had one problem. My Fleetwood sat in a garage for twelve years collecting dust. On top of that, the car has white leather, which was never properly cleaned. The problem is that the white leather was a dirty gray. It was frustrating, because you could see the leather was still very supple. I tried the old standby Lexol, but to no avail. I cleaned the leather with Lexol and it looked almost as dirty as before I cleaned it. If I had to grade the cleaning of the leather with 10 being the dirtiest and one being perfectly clean (the leather was so dirty, it had dirt in the pores), the leather was a 9 after the Lexol cleaning. Uh, oh, what to do?! You can say that I was distressed.

Fast forward ahead a couple of weeks and a friend of mine was visiting for dinner. You must understand that Lorri is into horses and has experience with leather saddles. Lorri saw the Cadillac for the first time and was delighted by the condition. She also saw how dirty the leather was and recommended using Hydrophane Lanilized Saddlesoap. It comes in a tub and is a cream soft type of soap and leather moisturizer/conditioner. She was very specific as to how the leather should be cleaned. Lorri suggested using a medium bristle slightly damp (with water) tooth brush with some of the soap in the bristles. You work the leather surface in circular and then back & forth motions until the dirt is lifted. You will see the dirt being lifted into the foaming soap. She suggested

also working a small area of the leather at a time (about 3 to 5 inches by 3 to 5 inches). Once you see the dirt being lifted, you take a clean paper towel and wipe off the foamy soap and dirt. You will also want to clean the brush after each section is cleaned. You will truly be amazed with the results. My dirty gray, number "9" leather went to factory new number "1" leather.

It was an understatement to say that I was very pleased and impressed with this Hydrophane product. The Hydrophane leaves the leather supple with a factory perfect surface and a light sheen. Hydrophane Saddlesoap is truly a miracle product. I never expected the leather to look so good. If you have any questions or would like guidance, you can reach me at home at 215-643-9229. As a testament to how well this specific Hydrophane product works, I was awarded the best detailing award by another car club that I belong to. Stay tuned, I have just discovered another Hydrophane product that gives a higher gloss to the leather for those of you who like more of a gloss.

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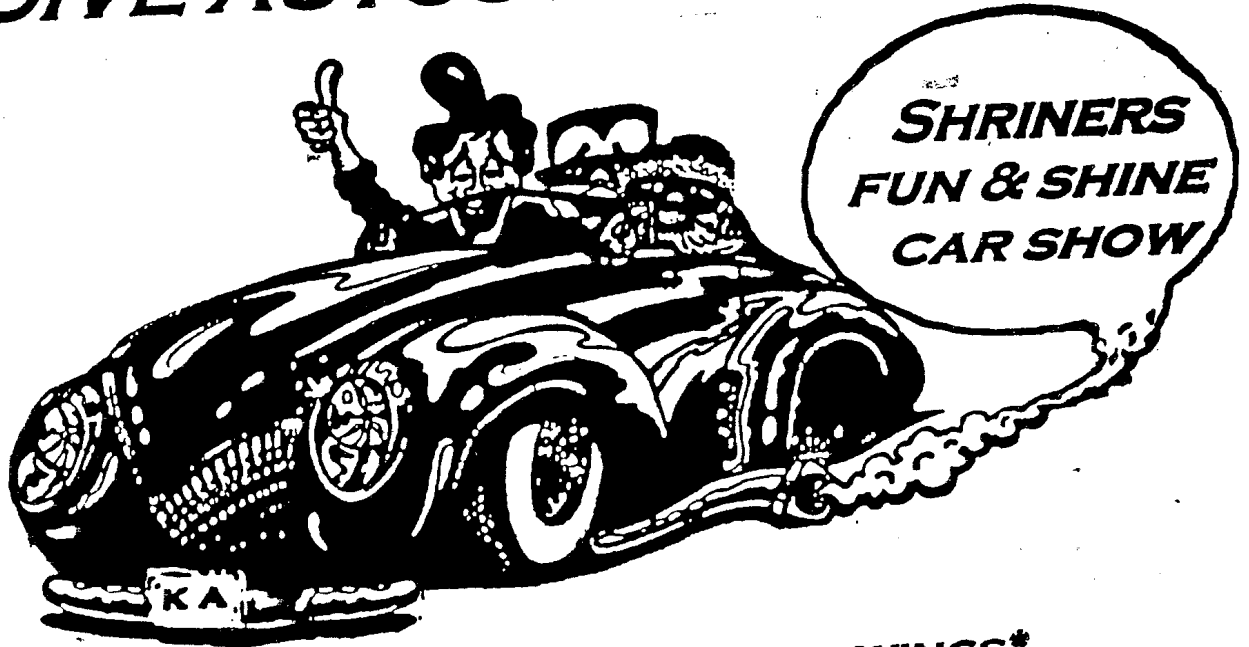
### **Paving the Way**
