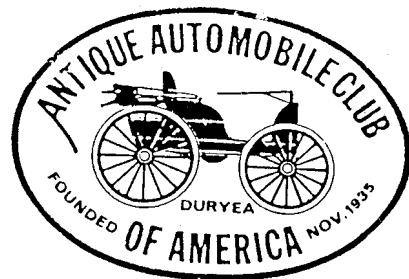
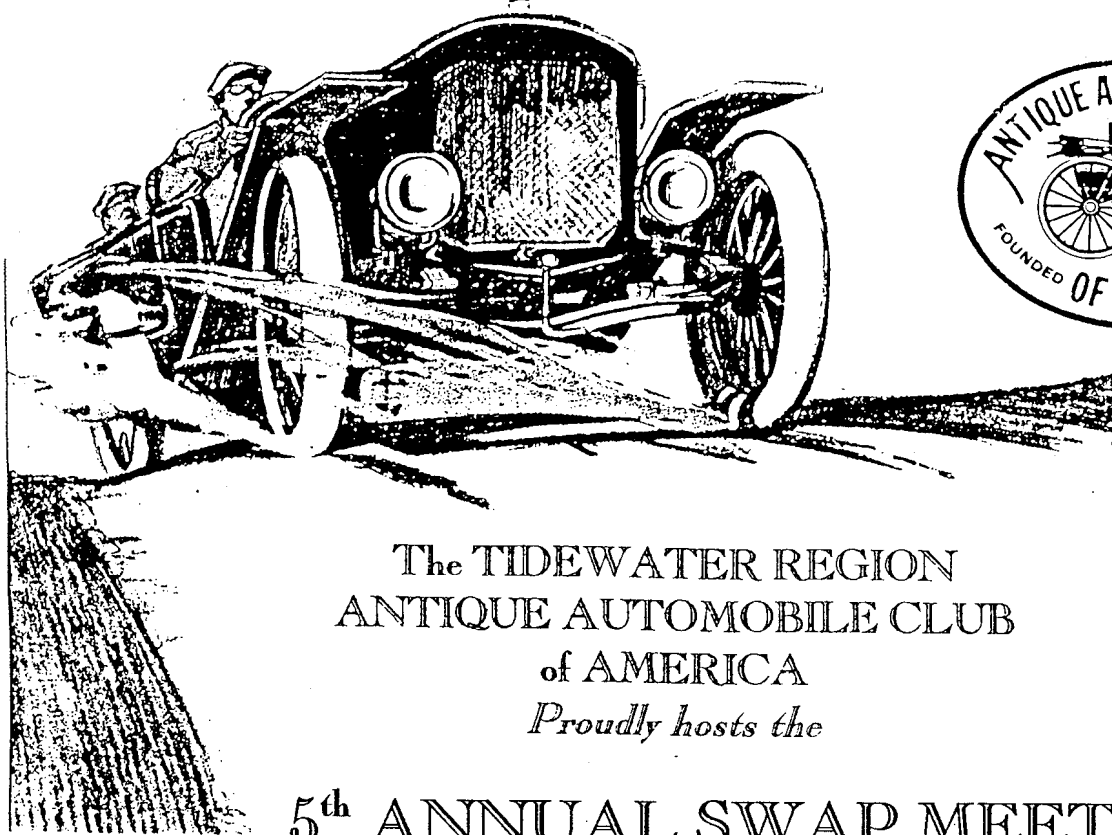
Next, I need to shift gears and do a little business. Dues are now due folks. By now you should have received you bill for dues from the national. Please take care of that detail now.

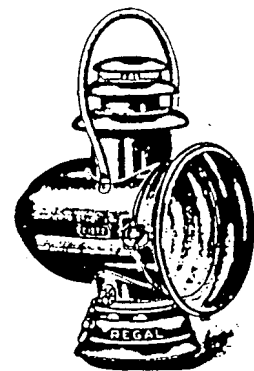
I would also like remind all members that the national club requires national membership in order to maintain regional membership.

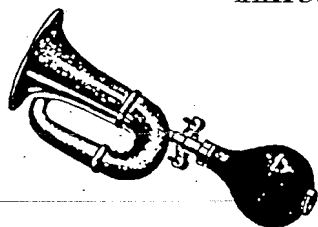
