

Easy Loom Knit Scrubby

What you will need for this project:

- *24 Peg Loom
- *Darning Needle
- *Scrubby Yarn (I used Red Heart Scrubby Yarn.)
- *Cotton Yarn (Lily Sugar 'n Cream)
- *Loom Knit Tool
- *Scissors

Start with an Ewrap cast on.

This pattern uses all Ewrap stitches.

Knit 14 rows for an average size scrubby and 16 for a larger size.

After Knitting the rows match the stitches by bringing each stitch up from the inside of the scrubby. The technique is very similar to matching a brim of a hat. Start with the anchor peg and move your way around the loom. Once you are finished, knit over each stitch.

It's time to take your scrubby off the loom! Wrap the working yarn around the loom 1 1/2 times and cut. Thread the darning needle with the yarn you cut. Start at the anchor peg and work the needle up through each peg. When you approach the last peg pull the scrubby off the loom. Pull on the yarn string to close up the hole. Sew the ends in. Enjoy your scrubby!
