Shrimp Fettuccine with Creamy Caper Sauce

- 1 Box [12oz] Spinach or Florentine Fettuccine [such as Ronzoni or San Giorgio]
- 1 T olive oil
- 1 small red onion halved and sliced
- 2 cloved garlic, sliced
- 1# cleaned raw shrimp, thawed if frozen
- 2/3 cup garden vegetable cream cheese [such as Philadelphia]
- 1/3 cup heavy cream
- 2 T fresh dill, chopped
- 2 T cappers
- 2 T lemon juice
- 1/2 t black pepper
- 1/4 t salt

Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add Fettuccine and stir so strands do not stick together.

Cook 12 minutes or as per package directions. Drain reserving 1/2 cup pasta water. Meanwhile, heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add onion and garlic. Cook for 5

minutes. Stir in shrimp, cream cheese, dill, caapers, onion, lemon juice, pepper and salt. Cook 3 to 5

minutes until shrimp is cooked thru.

Stir pasta into sauce along with reserved pasta water. Serve immediately
