From Our Historian

In October 1970 There was a reminder that club dues were now due! There was a discussion about 18 to 21 year old members but nothing was decided. There was talk of the 1971 convention in St. Louis with a limit of 700 cars. Budweiser had agreed to supply all the beer for the convention and would like to know how much beer this group can consume!!

In October 1980 The trustees were trying to get the responsibilities of the Officers written up and are trying to get them done for the newsletter. 67 cars have run in homecomings so far There was the discussion to raise the cost of each car to \$12.00 but it was decided it wasn't necessary. A suggestion was made there could be a 5 car minimum per school. The October speed event was canceled due to lack of a place to have it.

In October of 1990 There was a reminder that there would be no newsletters in December. Terry Kocher reported that the July Autocross made \$80.00. Jim Bemus was voted in as a new member. The club voted to adopt a highway for a year. The meeting was held at Isabel's Palace on First Avenue. A big thank you went to Bob Bowen for the Funkana and Blind Autocross. There was a color run sponsored by the Suburban Corvettes of Minnesota. The dates were Oct. 5th thru the 7th. The club headquartered at Midway Motor Lodge. 148 Corvettes participated. Hopefully future reports will tell us how many CRCC members attended.

In October 2000 Homecoming Director Di Neal reported that the club had made history with 21 homecomings this year. In 1994 there were 13. One half the money made from homecomings is donated to Camp Courageous by the club. CRCC will have a memorial brick at the swimming pool at Camp Courageous. Kathy Willenborg thanked all members who donated toiletries. Several boxes were taken to the Catherine McAuley Center for women. A motion passed to send Police Chief Robert Harmann of McGreggor a CRCC hat. The chief directed traffic as the cars were passing thru McGreggor.

In October of 2011 Pat McGrath gave CRCC a new 6 yr agreement to remain our Major Sponsor. President Tom Oakley is closing his presidency. He reminds us that we have had outings with Cedar Valley Street Rods, The Naked Riding Wessel's and the Midwest Corvette Club. Larry Armbrecht was organizing the Halloween party and Gary Cummings was organizing the leaf run. Paul and Jan Hildebrand provided a quiz along the way. Fun times and great memories!!

In October of 2020 The pandemic just kept rolling along. Terry and Dennis Primrose left us all home and went to the National Corvette Club Museum where they picked up last years banner. They then spent a few days in Nashville. Finding a place for a meeting has been a real challenge due to social distancing. Janice Bowers has been hanging in there finding places for us to go even in tough times!!
