Healthcare costs

Intangible costs

Costs which are difficult to value financially (e.g. pain, anxiety and loss of energy; time given up by voluntary caregivers).

Direct costs and indirect costs

Direct costs are related to a particular patient and include compounding costs, patient education, therapeutic drug monitoring....

The term indirect costs describe costs which do not change directly from a single treatment, test or service. These are essentially overhead costs such as cost of heating, electricity, internet connection, phone, building lease, staff training, equipment...
