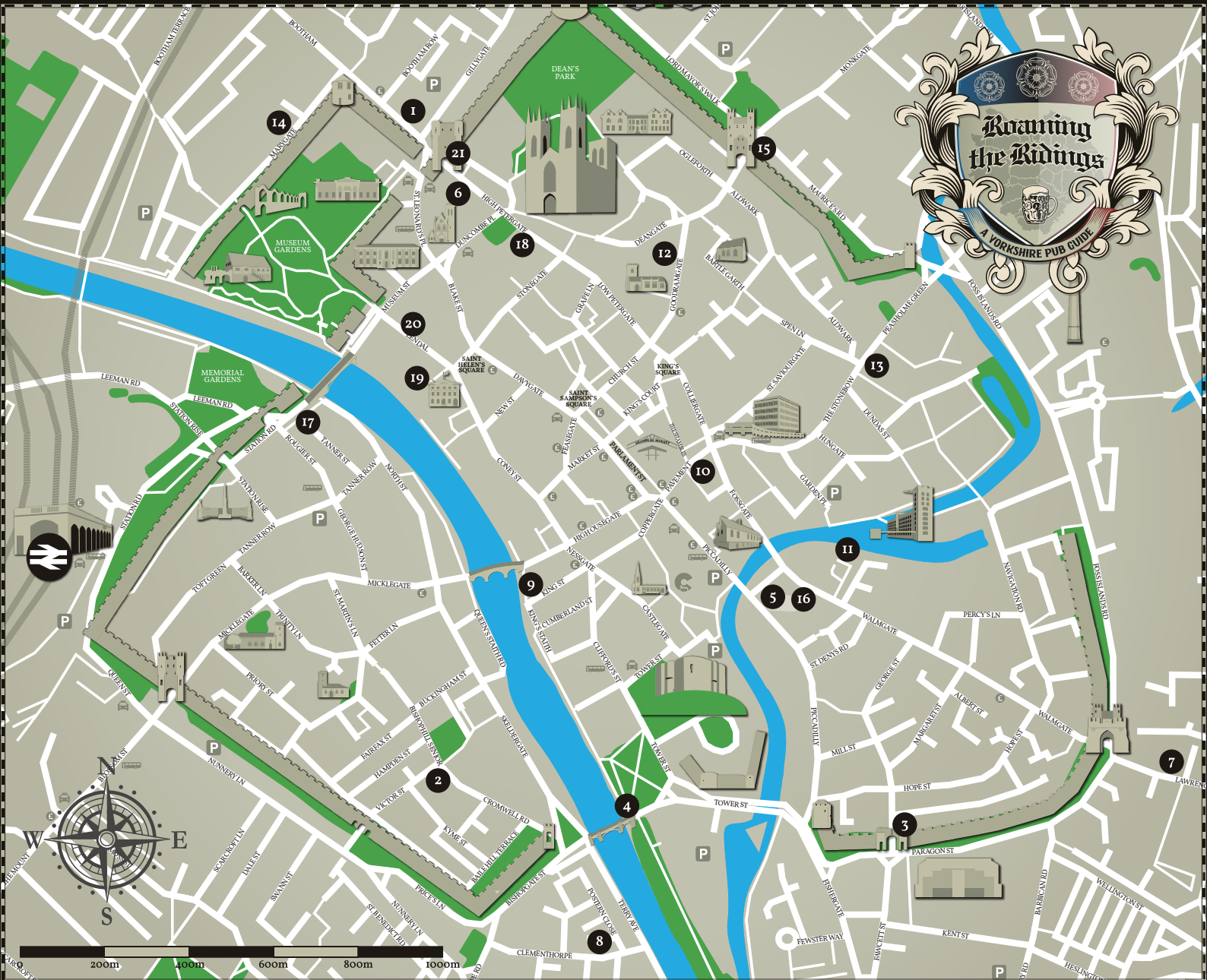


• YORK'S BEST BEER GARDENS •



 <p>1) The Exhibition A secluded and peaceful long walled Beer Garden with loads of space and seating, covered sections, quirky decoration and established plants.</p>	 <p>2) The Golden Ball Peaceful long 'L' shaped well planted walled courtyard, partially roofed with plenty of seating and a cosy secluded atmosphere to relax in.</p>	 <p>3) Phoenix Inn A beautiful and sunny little walled garden hunkering right up by the City Walls and looking out along the embankment.</p>
 <p>4) Dyls A small open paved area right on the edge of the river situated by Skeldergate Bridge in a small park.</p>	 <p>5) Spark York This temporary container village is unique with its open plan design, there are plenty of bars and food vendors to choose from over two levels.</p>	 <p>6) Eagle & Child A bright and welcoming spacious walled courtyard with plenty of seating.</p>
 <p>7) The Waggon & Horses A nice simple long yard to the side of the car park, open and airy with lots of seating. A peaceful space on the outskirts of the town centre.</p>	 <p>8) The Slip Inn A very large and spacious yard to the back with plenty of seating and a peaceful atmosphere away from the hustle and bustle of the town centre.</p>	 <p>9) Kings Arms The infamous riverside cobbled seating area in front of the pub by Ouse Bridge. The only problem can be finding space as it's a very popular location.</p>
 <p>10) Golden Fleece Large decked courtyard with covered pergola sections and ample seating, a lovely secluded gem.</p>	 <p>11) Brew York Tap Room Half covered yard looking out onto the river Foss and Rowntrees Wharf at the back of the Tap Room. To the front is the spacious Brewers Yard with loads of seating.</p>	 <p>12) The Habit Small first floor decked terrace with fabulous views of the Minster, well worth a visit.</p>
 <p>13) The Black Swan Inn A good sized yard area with a covered walkway section which opens out into a decked space with plenty of tables.</p>	 <p>14) Minster Inn Small but perfectly formed, this quaint and cosy garden is tucked away at the back of the pub under pergolas and a variety of seating.</p>	 <p>15) The Keystones A long and large beer garden which runs to the side and behind the pub up against the City Walls, features a Georgian Ice House at the bottom. Very popular.</p>
 <p>16) Walmgate Ale House Hidden away at the back of the pub is a lovely little enclosed yard with several benches centred around a small tree.</p>	 <p>17) The Maltings Decked terrace to the side of the pub lined with gabions, two awnings with heating and good views of the City Walls and Lendal Bridge.</p>	 <p>18) Guy Fawkes Inn You might not catch much sun in this cosy yard but it's a great little space surround by decorative architecture and an impressive wall mural.</p>
 <p>19) Lendal Cellars Secluded large yard hidden away at the back of the pub, a great space surrounded by ancient buildings.</p>	 <p>20) Judges Lodgings Very spacious paved area with old trees to front of pub and a terraced area to rear, the clientele can be a little raucous though.</p>	 <p>21) The Fat Badger A lovely terraced garden tucked up by the City Walls and surrounded by tress, stunning views of the Minster but steep narrow access and the pub isn't our favourite.</p>
