The Reston & District Library will be offering CELA one-disk audio books for people with print disabilities that are played on a Victor Reader player.

The library also has three Victor Reader players to loan out to people who wish to listen to these one-disk audio books. We also have one Victor Reader Stream. This device can receive books electronically. This device can be loaded with audio books at the library and then picked up by care-givers or support workers for the person with a print disability. Or, if patrons have wifi they could receive audio books remotely, so that they can enjoy audio stories.

We are presently cataloging the one-disk audio books for patrons who wish to listen to audio stories. These one-disk audio books can be picked up by a patron, a care-give or a support worker.

In the Spring, we will hold CELA presentations in senior housing complexes and the Reston Drop-In in Reston.
