


Dear Auxiliary Sisters,

Since 1989 the Michigan State Auxiliary, has been awarding the "Isabel Vallie/Imogene Harac Award" to an Auxiliary Sister who has given unselfishly of her time in furthering the welfare of her Auxiliary, and the Fraternal Order of Eagles. **IN ADDITION, SHE HAS GIVEN OF HER TIME TO HER COMMUNITY.**

If your Auxiliary wishes to submit a sister for this award, the following rules **MUST** be complied with:

1. An Auxiliary may submit only one name each year.
2. The applicant **MAY NOT** be a State Officer or Past State President.
3. Any member in good standing who has been a member of your Auxiliary for Ten (10) years or more may be nominated.
4. Your letter **MUST** include the date the nominee was initiated.
5. She need not be a past or present officer of your Auxiliary
6. Submit a letter of your sister's qualifications, and include the date the motion was passed on the Auxiliary floor. The President, Secretary and a Past President **MUST** sign the letter, with the **AUXILIARY SEAL ON IT**. If the President or Secretary's name is submitted, a second Past President must sign the letter.
7. Send your entry by **CERTIFIED MAIL** postmarked no later than **March. 17th, 2026** to Michigan State Auxiliary, F.O.E. Julie Kassner, State Secretary, at 620 E. Slocum St. Whitehall, MI 49461.
8. **ON THE BOTTOM LEFT HAND CORNER OF YOUR ENVELOPE** Place "**ATTENTION: ISABEL VALLIE/IMOGENE HARAC AWARD COMMITTEE**".

Please make sure you follow all of the rules, as some letters have been disqualified in the past, due to the Auxiliary **NOT** following **ALL** of the rules.

We are sure there are many deserving sisters throughout our State, so let's hear from you.

- Pull your list of **recently** dropped members from **July** of this year as well as dropped members from previous years and mail them an invitation to re-join your Aerie/Auxiliary. Mention **new and exciting** things you are doing at your Aerie/Auxiliary to encourage them to re-join!
- The Aerie/Auxiliary can decide to offer a period of time to waive re-enrollment fees (the Aerie/Auxiliary votes to cover the fees, for the reenrolled members) **REMEMBER the Grand Aerie will still charge the \$10 fee** per re-enrolled member.
- Have a special **"Welcome back"** event (fish fry, dinner and a band) and invite dropped members to re-enroll at the event.







MICHIGAN STATE AUXILIARY F.O.E TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) All monies used for tournament Expenses and profits from tournament will go to the HOST AUXILIARY
- 2) Tournament for 2026 is a Sanctioned and NON-Sanctioned Handicap Tournament consisting of Four Women Team Event, Doubles, Singles and All Events A Participation fee of \$5.00 for non-sanctioned bowlers, this fee to State Madam Presidents Charity
- 3) All bowlers must be AUXILIARY MEMBERS in good standing at the time of bowling. EAGLES RECEIPT MUST BE SHOWN with Sanction Card if bowling as a sanctioned bowler.
BEFORE THE START OF BOWLING. AUXILIARY PER CAPITA TAX MUST BE PAID.
- 4) **ONLY HOST AUXILIARY TO RUN ANY JACKPOTS**
- 5) All USBC Rules and Regulations will govern this tournament. USBC rule 319d will not apply Rule 319e will be enforced, 15 or more pins increase in average, bowler must report and use higher average.
- 6) The Tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis of 90 percent of the difference of your highest league (book average) and 220 as of July 31st, 2025, 21 games or more. A bowler without average 21 as of July 31st, 2025, shall be permitted to use her current average if she has 24 or more games by the time she bowls the tournament (bowler must provide a league standing sheet or other proof of average.) An entrant with no established average must use a 150 average, plus handicap.
- 7) It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of her scores. All scoring corrections must be turned into Tournament Secretary no later than 24 hours after bowling or will be disqualified
- 8) Team captains must report to Secretary Office One (1) hour before bowling. NO change in lineup will be made except for substitutes. In case of substitutes, the Captain will make changes.
- 9) NO more than two (2) substitutes will be allowed for each team. All averages subject to rule 5.
- 10) Price per event will be left to the Host Auxiliary, as the price of bowling varies in different cities. Those wishing to enter All events must send all event fees with entry blank.
- 11) Women may bowl twice in team event with a change of two bowlers from the original line up. Twice in doubles with a change in partner. Once in singles and all events. First scores from team event, doubles and singles will make up all events score.
- 12) Any Player or team arriving late will begin with the frame being bowled receiving zero for the missed frames
- 13) RESERVATIONS BY MAIL OR BLANK ENTRY AND FEES ONLY. Entries will be treated on a first – come basis. An acknowledgement will be sent back within 48 hours. Entry blanks must be filled out in full for the records and all entry fees must accompany the entry blanks. No fees will be accepted after the close of entries.
- 14) Individual awards for Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events will be based on Handicap scores only.
- 15) Average submitted by team or individuals winning prize will be verified. Failure to use correct averages shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the current average. CORRECTION IN AVERAGES MAY BE SUBMITTED UP TO THE COMPLETION OF THE FIRST GAME OF THE SERIES BOWLED.
- 16) All prizes will be determined by number of entries received. At least one (1) prize for each ten (10) entries or major fraction thereof will be paid in each event. All prize fees paid in each event will return 100 percent as prizes in that event. It is not necessary to enter all three (3) events unless you complete for All event prizes. Entrants must pay for doubles and singles; however, they do not have to bowl in both but must declare which they are bowling on entry form. When bowling the second time you only have to pay for the event you are bowling.
- 17) No monies will be refunded after being received by the Tournament Secretary.
- 18) Host Auxiliary must have the entry blanks out for the tournament by November 15th, 2024
- 19) A prize list and prize monies will be sent to MICHIGAN STATE BOWLING CHARIMAN AND ALL TEAM CAPTAINS within thirty (30) days of end of tournament.
- 20) Only Team Captains will vote for the next Host city for the MICHIGAN STATE EAGLES AUXILIARY BOWLING TOURNAMENT with team consent.
- 21) THREE (3) HOURS WILL BE ALLOWED FOR TEAM EVENT, FOUR (4) HOURS WILL BE ALLOWED FOR DOUBLES AND SINGLES.
- 22) ALL ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID BY MONEY ORDER, CERTIFIED CHECK, OR AUXILIARY NO PERSONAL CHECK ACCEPTED.
- 23) THERE CAN BE NO CAMPAIGNING BY THE HOST AUXILIARY TO THE NEXT TOURNAMENT

Lansing, Michigan – Double Tree Hotel/Lansing Center - June 11th, 12th, and June 13th, 2026

Madam Secretary – Please, read to your Auxilliary and keep, for reference.

The 78th Annual Convention of the Michigan State Auxiliary F.O.E. Headquarters will be at the Double Tree Hotel/Lansing Center, Lansing, Michigan. The State Aerie and State Auxilliary will host the Convention as they have in the past. The Auxilliary will start registration on Wednesday, June 10th, 2026, starting at 2:00 p.m. at the Convention Headquarters on the 2nd level of the hotel.

All the Convention Committee meeting room numbers will be posted at the Registration Desk. If you are asked by the State Madam President to serve on a committee, your meeting will be at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday. **NOTE: The Credential Committee will meet at 12:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 10th 2026, in the DoubleTree Regency 1 Room, so the committee will be ready to open Registration to the Delegates and Members at 2:00 p.m.**

Delegates: The State Auxiliary by-laws allow each Auxiliary that has filed its required reports and **HAS PAID ITS PER CAPITA TAX IN FULL** based on the June 2025 Annual Report not including Dual Members – one (1) vote for each twenty-five (25) members or major fraction thereof. This means that if you are 13 more into the next 25 members your Auxiliary gets one more Auxiliary vote. This does not mean you must send a Delegate for each vote, as an Auxiliary delegate may carry as many as three (3) Auxiliary votes, and if she is a PMP or TYS she gets one additional vote. If she is not an Auxiliary Delegate, but a Past Madam President or Ten-Year Secretary and wishes to vote, she must register paying the required Registration fee. No registration changes in category will be permitted once registered. **NO SISTER MAY CARRY MORE THAN 3 AUXILIARY VOTES**, however if they are a Past Madam President or a Ten-Year Secretary, she would get one (1) additional vote, and if she is also a State Officer or a Past State Madam President, she would get one (1) more vote.

The credential sheets, **three (3)** for listing Auxiliary, delegates, and alternates and **ALL** Past Madam Presidents, are enclosed. Secretaries – please read the instructions before filling out the credential sheets. **DO NOT REDUCE THE DELEGATE SHEETS, AS THEY ARE USED FOR OUR REGISTRATION AND ELECTION BOOKS.**

List Auxiliary Delegates first, write the name of the delegate, then **D** for Auxiliary delegate after her name. If the delegate is a Past Madam President, write her name and put a **D** and **P.M.P.** after her name. Now after the delegate list the alternate and add **A** after her name (do not give the alternate any votes). Now skip two lines and then list **ALL** the "alive" Past Madam Presidents or Ten-Year Secretaries (TYS), even if they do not plan to attend the Convention. Many times, they will change their mind, and unless listed on the credential sheet, she may lose her vote.

Example: Members on which State Per Capita Tax has been paid **388** as of June 30, 2025 (this means number of members on your rolls **NOT** including Dual Members), Total Auxiliary Votes **16** (you will note that in the sample this Auxiliary only used **9** of their **16** votes losing 7 votes).

All three (3) credential sheets must be identically filled out with the Auxiliary **SEAL** on each and mailed to the State Secretary, Julie Kassner/Campbell, at 620 E. Slocum St. Whitehall, MI 49461.

PLEASE DO NOT WRITE IN THE CREDENTIAL NUMBER COLUMN, as this column is used by the State Secretary to assign the delegate credential numbers. **Do not enter the Grand Aerie ID number in this column.**

NOTE: A sister that receives her Gold Card prior to the State Convention **IS** considered a Past Madam President and should receive her PMP vote – the same for a sister that receives her Gold Card prior to State Convention that she is a Ten-Year Secretary (TYS).

NOTE – Our State Madam President appoints the Convention Committees from the Credential Sheets, so please mail it back to the State Secretary prior to **April 18, 2026**, so a copy may be given to her.

NOTICE: Late changes in Auxiliary Delegates or Alternates must have a letter from the Auxiliary Secretary to present to the Credential Committee at the Registration Desk. **The Auxiliary Seal must be affixed to the letter.**

MEMBER PRE-REGISTRATION – This form is used for registering members that are coming to the Convention that are not delegates or a Past Madam President.

MEMORIAL SERVICES – The Joint Aerie and Auxiliary Memorial Service will be held on Thursday, June 11, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. in the Lansing Center Banquet Rooms 1-8.

SESSIONS – The first Michigan State Auxiliary Session will begin on Thursday, June 11, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. **SHARP.** All sessions will begin at 9:00 a.m. **SHARP.** Sisters, please remember that we have a dress code for our sessions. **NO SHORTS, HALTER TOPS, SPANDEX or ATTIRE ABOVE THE KNEE** is permitted and the Guards at the doors will enforce this.

REGISTRATION – Delegates Registration is **\$40.00**, and Banquet tickets are **\$40.00**. Each Auxiliary must allow their accredited Auxiliary Delegates, expenses over and above registration and banquet tickets. **Please make out separate checks for the Delegate Fees and the Banquet Tickets.** All Checks should be made payable to **Michigan State Auxiliary F.O.E. Convention Fund and must be an Auxiliary check, and signed with three signatures.** Send to State Secretary, Julie Campbell, along with the Delegate sheets and the Banquet Ticket Reservation form. **SEND ALL THREE (3) COPIES OF THE DELEGATE SHEETS AND THE TICKET RESERVATION FORM PRIOR TO APRIL 18, 2026.** One copy of the Delegate sheet is used by the State Madam President to appoint the Convention Committees, one copy is used by the Registration Committee, and one copy is used by the Election Committee. **Please make sure all three copies are signed by the Madam Secretary with the Auxiliary Seal affixed.** Past Madam Presidents not wanting a Banquet Ticket may register for **\$40.00**, which includes a badge and a program book. A Member Registration is **\$40.00**, which includes a badge and a program book. A separate Member Registration sheet is enclosed. **A Past Madam President or Ten-Year Secretary** is considered a delegate even if she is not a delegate sent by the Auxiliary this year.

BANQUET FORMAT- Banquet reservation form is included in this bulletin. Please return with a check or money order prior to **April 18, 2026**. This form is used for ordering tickets for your delegates as well as any visitors or guests that wish to attend. If your group wishes to sit together, we must receive the form and check together.

1. All tables will be assigned on a first come basis at the time of purchase, and no changes can be made after the table is assigned.


