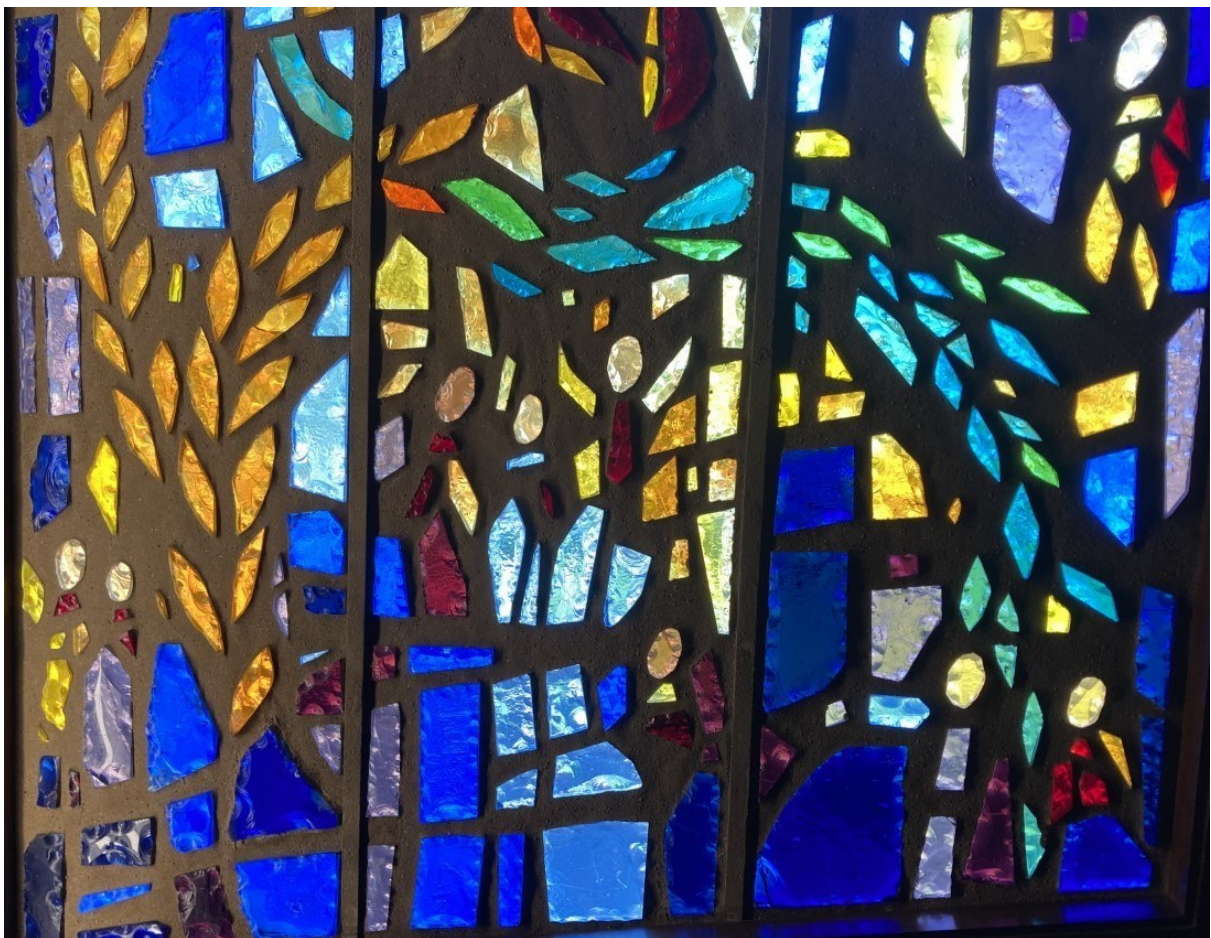

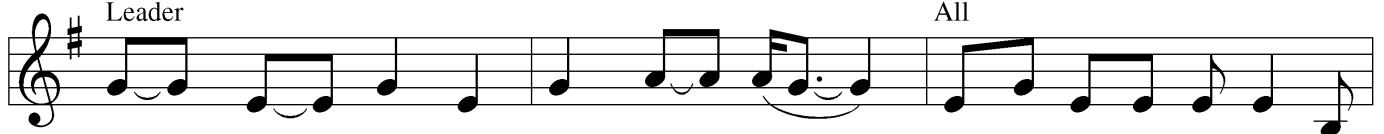

SECOND READING—Acts 19:1-7

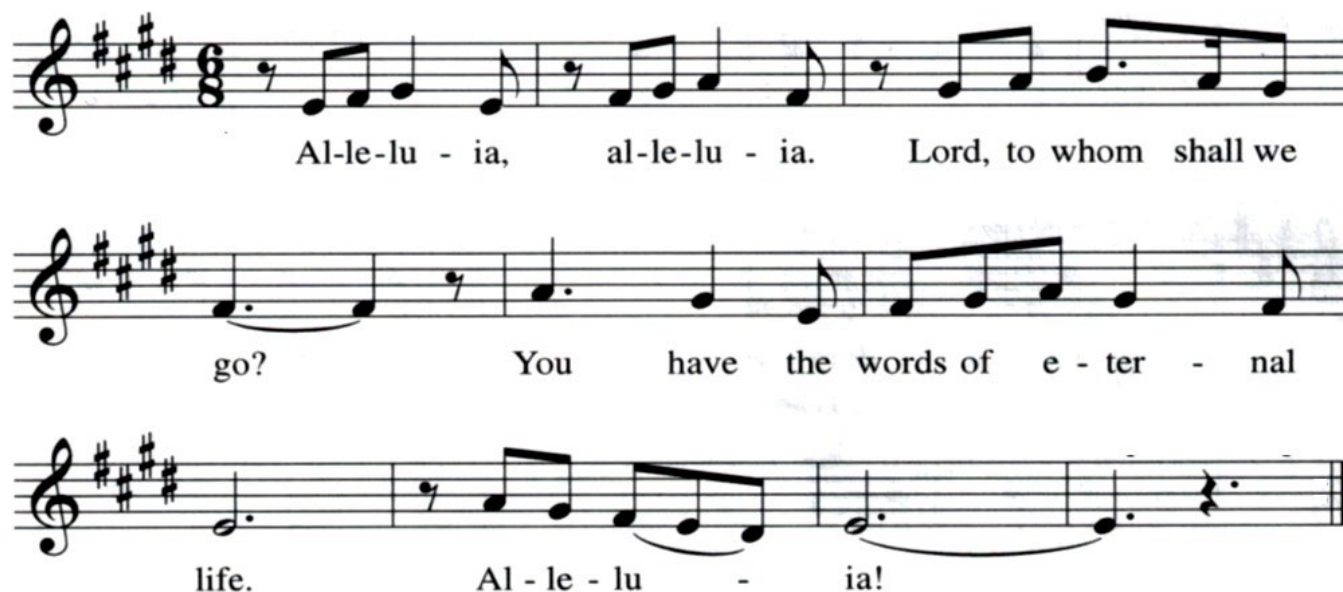

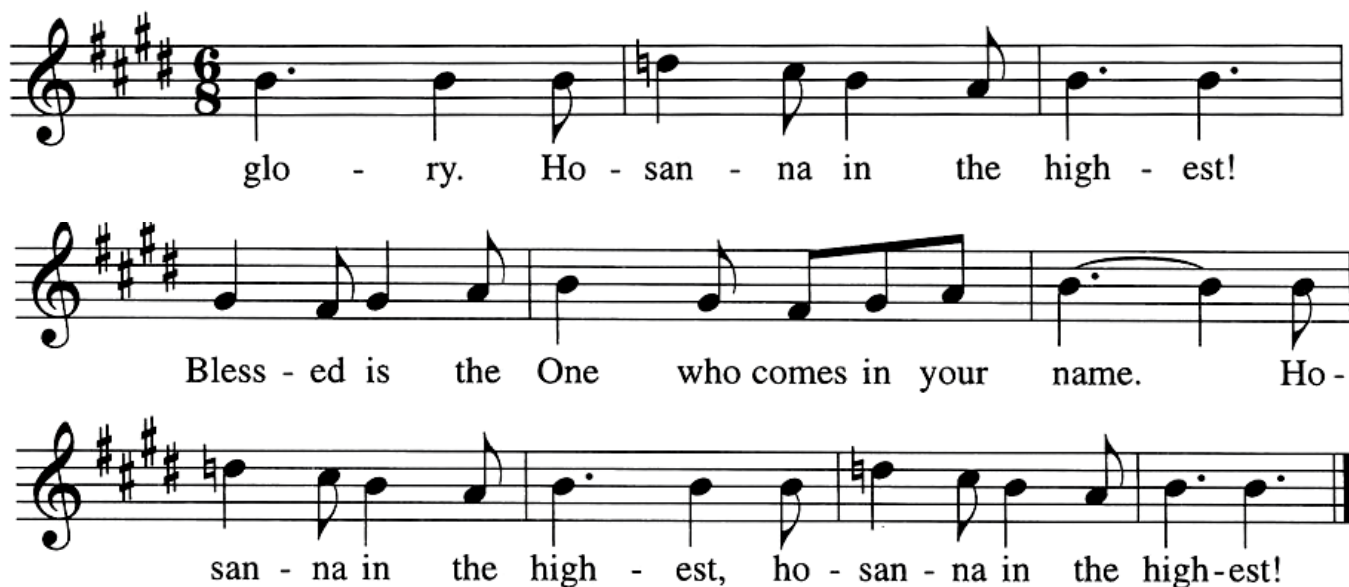
