



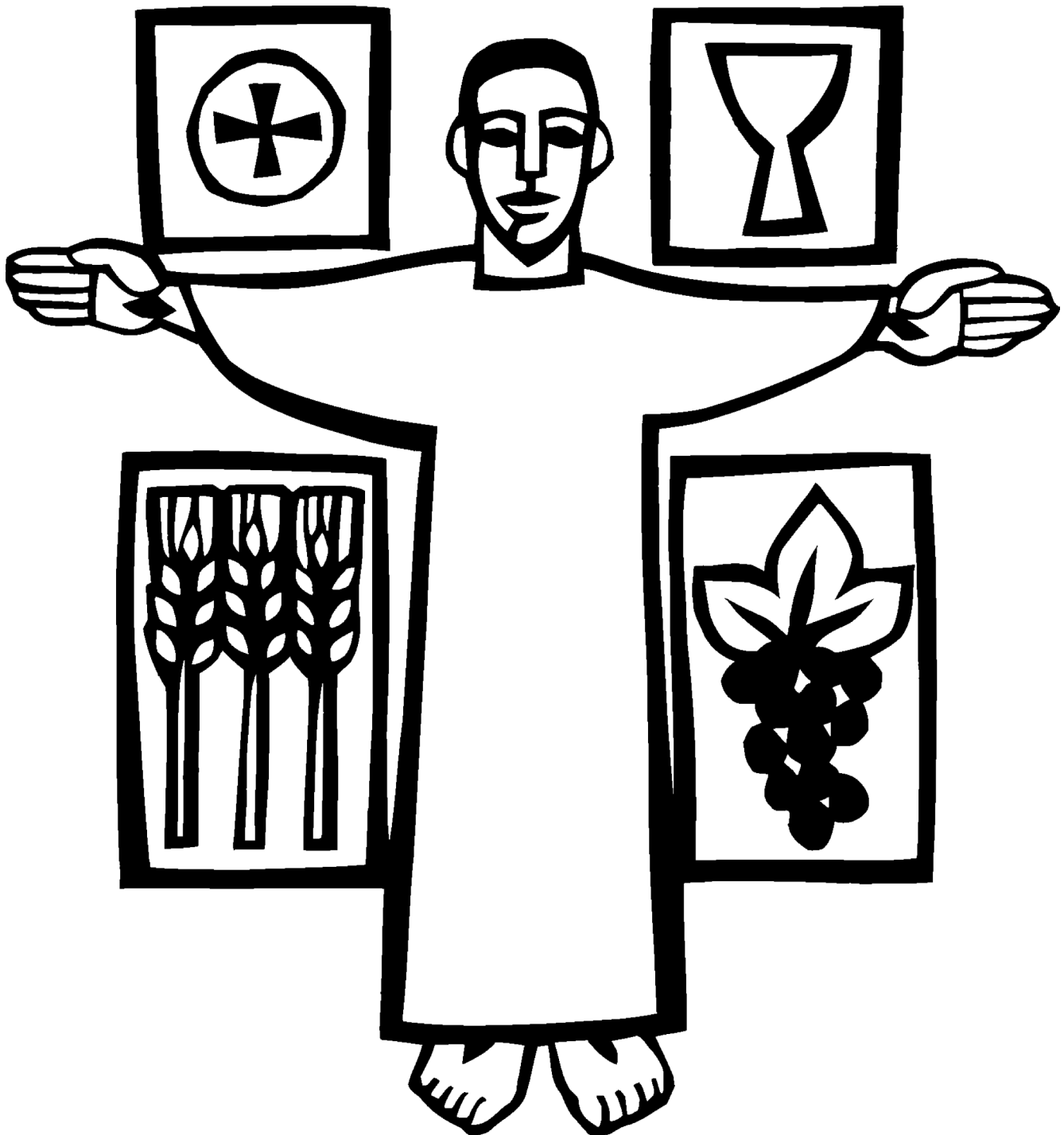

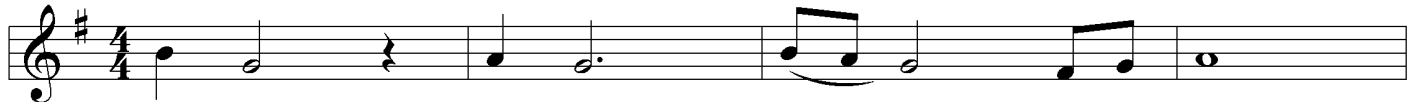

Whoever eats of this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh.”
