#### RESPOND WITH GRATITUDE FOR GOD'S CREATION

A monthly message from your Stewardship Ministry Team

"Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it." (Genesis 3:18)

As this verse from the creation story recorded in Genesis makes clear, the responsibility for the care and protection of the earth lies squarely at the feet of all individuals created in the image of God. It is our duty to care for the earth, a task that many believe we have done a poor job of fulfilling, but one that nevertheless is part of humankind's God-given responsibility.

Being a steward of God's creation takes many forms. Recycling, reducing waste, using energy efficient appliances, installing LED lighting, and exploring solar and other forms of renewable resources to name but a few.

Holy Trinity has been involved in all these areas of being good stewards of our planet and the resources it provides for our everyday living. We recycle all paper products, we do not use Styrofoam cups during coffee fellowship, we have installed LED lighting in the sanctuary and are securing ways to do the same in the CLC, and have explored, in the past, the installation of a renewable solar generating system. All these are made possible by all of us working together to insure we fulfill God's mandate to "till the earth and keep it."


