To nominate a candidate into the NYFAB Hall of Fame the candidate should qualify in either the Competitive or Administrative category (see Hall of Fame rules). The candidates resume and picture must be sent to me by January 30th. All nominations shall be submitted in a WORD document to the following email address: ISCMPAUL@GMAIL.COM. The nominations shall also include a photo of the nominee. As chairman of the Hall of Fame I will then submit all resumes received, prior to the deadline, to the members of the NYFAB Hall of Fame for their review and vote. All newly elected Hall of Fame members will be officially inducted into the NYFAB Hall of Fame at the Annual HOF Meeting/Indoor Championship in March.




New York Field Archers & Bowhunters Association- Hall of Fame Rules- December 2024

- A. The Hall of Fame was established by NYFA (currently NYFAB) in 1972 to honor members of the association who have been outstanding in their achievements with bow and arrow, fine sportsmanship or dedication and exceptional contributions to the organization or administration of archery. It is the highest honor that can be bestowed on a member of the organization.
- B. All members of the Hall of Fame shall comprise the committee to consider proposed candidates.
- C. Hall of Fame members shall appoint a chairman each year (at the meeting held during the weekend of the association's annual meeting and state indoor championship).
- D. Nominations and resumes of the candidates' achievements shall be received by the chairman from a recognized NYFAB League, Club or the NYFAB Board of Directors by December 31 in the year of nomination. Leagues, Clubs and NYFAB Board should carefully screen any candidates they submit.
- E. The chairman shall send resumes and recommendations of proposed candidates to each {currently active} member of the Hall of Fame after a careful investigation. Members will vote on the candidates by either returning their completed ballots to the chairman by mail or email prior to the Annual Meeting by a date prescribed by the chairman. The Chairman does not vote except in the case of ties and will announce inductees to the Hall of Fame during the weekend of the annual Meeting/Indoor Championship of NYFAB. Until then members of the Hall of Fame are asked to keep this information confidential.
- F. No more than two (2) people per year will be inducted. There are two (2) categories- administrative and competitive. Only one honor will be bestowed in each. To be eligible in the Administrative category the candidate must have worked at the State level and/or higher. To be eligible in the Competitive category the candidate must have won a specific style championship at the state level or higher (not just a generic statement saying that the candidate has won, but also the style and year of each win). All candidates must be members of NYFAB for at least ten (10) years and be at least 21 years of age. A clear photograph of the candidate must be included with all submitted resumes.
- G. Current members of the Hall of Fame may be submitted for a Second Endorsement into the Hall of Fame in another category from their original entry. (Eg. If inducted under Competitive can be submitted for 2nd Endorsement in the Administrative or vice versa. Second Endorsement nominees will be required to be submitted by the same rules as listed in "F" above. Voting for 2nd Endorsement will be done under a "Yes" or "No" vote by current Hall of Fame members and there will be no limit as to how many may receive 2nd Endorsements each year. A special Hall of Fame pin and certificate will be awarded as well as an additional notification on the NYFAB Hall of Fame Plaque.
- H. It is not necessary that a member be inducted into the Hall of Fame each year. An unsuccessful candidate may be re-nominated in a succeeding year if the sponsoring organization so chooses.
- I. People approved for membership into the Hall of Fame will be installed during the weekend of the NYFAB Annual Meeting and Indoor Championship.
