

# Virtual Indoor League

## **LEAGUE SEASON**

November 1 - February 28

## **ARCHER ENTRY FEE** *(in addition to local league fees)*

Ages 18+: \$25    Ages under 18: \$15

Paid directly online to NYFAB by each archer (no range responsibility)

## **MONETARY PROFIT FOR RANGES \$\$**

Ranges receive \$20 from each adult, and \$10 from each archer under 18. One lump sum check mailed to each club at the end of the season. \$5 from each registrant goes into the purse for the Range of the Year payout. In 2025 we paid back \$3,215 across the 18 ranges that participated. *(Pay backs based on participation at each location).*

***NYFAB takes ZERO money from this, all money goes directly back to the ranges!***

## **RANGE REQUIREMENTS**

- Ranges must have an NFAA Charter and Range Inspection while collecting scores
- Range Representative must enter all scores for their locations into a provided google sheet (excel) by March 2nd. Scores do not have to be updated weekly.

## **INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS**

- NFAA Membership required
  - *Any NEW junior members who have a S3DA, JOAD or NASP membership qualify for a 1 year free membership trial, contact NYFAB for more info*
- Must have at least 5 scores recorded by February 28th
- Must pay local league fees, PLUS NYFAB Virtual League Fee

## **LEAGUE FORMAT**

- Vegas multicolor 3 spot/single spot
- 300 round (10 ends of 3)
  - Leagues with 450 or 600 scores only use the first 10 ends
- Archers compete in their own NFAA equipment style/age group
- Top 5 scores for each individual count towards their final total
- Highest total of the 5 scores is the Champion in each division

## **RANGE OF THE YEAR SHOOTOFF**

- Each range will have the opportunity to have their top THREE archers shootoff at the State Championship (any mix of ages and equipment styles)
- Shootoff will occur Saturday evening at the State Championship in front of a crowd!
  - 4 ends on a Vegas face, x scores as an 11
  - Archers will rotate one arrow at a time on and off the line shooting at their teams target
    - Each individual will have one arrow in the target each end
- If a top ranked archer cannot attend, the next lowest may participate
- Ranges with less than 3 participants cannot participate
- Winning team earns the pot of money; \$5 from each registered archer of the league

# 2025 NYFAB Range Of The Year

---

Do you think your Range has the top shooters in the State? Do you want some extra cash for your facility? Then if so, this new award is for you!

NYFAB is taking \$5 from every Virtual League participant and putting it into a pot of money for one Club or Shop to take home at the Indoor State Championship. Example, if there are 200 shooters across the state, there will be a \$1,000 prize available. The more shooters that sign up for the Indoor League, the higher the prize amount will be!



## **Who is Eligible?**

Any NYFAB Range that had at least 3 Virtual League participants, AND they attend the Indoor State Championship. Ranges who have less than 3 archers attend the State Championship will not be eligible. The top 3 archers (based on Virtual League score) from your Range present at the State Championship will be your "team". There are no divisions or class separations, it is simply your range's highest scoring archers. Cubs (10 yd archers) are allowed to be on your team.

## **What is the Format?**

The 3 archers will compete in a shootoff Saturday afternoon at the State Championship, after the last line time. The format will be similar to a World Archery event where 1 teammate will step up to the line at time and the 3 archers will rotate in, one shot at a time. They will be shooting at a Vegas 3 spot target, each archer will shoot one arrow into the target per end. Scoring will be cumulative for the team, and include an 11 for the super x. Teams will each shoot 4 ends, high score at the end will take home the prize. If there is a tie there will be a shootoff of one end, whichever arrow is closest to the center of any archer on the team wins.

## **Prizes**

The winning team will win the pot of money for their Club/Shop. Each individual on the winning team will also win \$100 each for themselves. What the Range decides to do with the money is up to them, there are no restrictions on it. The winning range will also receive a large "happy gilmore" style check to take home.
