

**2025 NYFAB INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP**  
**MARCH 14-15, 2026 - RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**Day 1 - Blue and White 300 Round**

1. The 40 cm "blue-face" NFAA 300 round will be shot consisting of 60 arrows, shot as three games, at a distance of 20 yards. Each game shall consist of four ends of five arrows per end. There will be 2 practice ends.
2. Target face will be the NFAA 40 cm blue/white face
3. Entrants may choose to shoot either the Single-spot target or the 5-spot target. Competitors must use the same target face throughout the round.
4. Cubs will shoot at 10 yards.
5. Archers must switch from top to bottom, bottom to top after half. Bottom shoots first.
6. Time limit: Timing standards will be employed for the 4 minutes allowed per end. Note: No arrow may be drawn prior to the whistle or shot after the time runs out. Any arrow shot after the time has run out, the highest scoring arrow will be pulled and not scored.
7. Sky Drawing, or drawing the bow with the bow hand above the head is not allowed, one warning will be given, after one warning the archer will be disqualified.
8. No ear buds, headphones, or any ear coverings allowed on the shooting line.
9. Shooters will be called to the shooting line by a whistle. Do not approach the line prior to whistle.
10. The maximum total width of the archer and all their equipment may not extend into the adjacent shooting lanes.
11. All shooters will straddle the shooting line in a reasonably even fashion.
12. No one is allowed on the shooting floor except officials and archers shooting the line.
13. Equipment failure: An official should be summoned to handle the situation. The archer will have THREE ENDS without holding up the tournament. The archer shall be allowed to shoot any amount of arrows during the three ends on their own bale. Archer must score starting on end four, or sooner. All make-up arrows will be shot at the end of the round.
14. Any arrow propelled fully beyond the 10-foot foul line is considered a shot arrow.
15. If an archer shoots more than the prescribed number of arrows in an end, the excess arrow or arrows of higher value will not be scored. A penalty of one (1) point (and X if applicable) will be assessed for each arrow shot over the prescribed number of arrows.
16. An archer may shoot the 5-spot target in any order, and shoot as many arrows into any spot as the archer desires, not to exceed the prescribed number of arrows per end.
17. Witnessed bounce outs and pass through in the scoring area will be re-shot. Summon an official to handle the situation. Arrows hanging from the front or rear of the target butt must be handled by a tournament official. Do not touch the arrow!
18. No arrow may be touched prior to the completion of scoring all arrows in the butt.
19. Single spot face scoring: X-5-4-3-2-1. 5-spot face scoring: X-5-4. X's for each end will be recorded. An arrow shaft needs only to touch the line to be counted in the area of the next higher value.

20. Each group will elect a target captain who will call the scores of all arrows on their target butt. Any discrepancies or questionable arrows must be handled by an official.
21. If the score cards reflect a difference in score per end PRIOR to archer signature, and the group cannot come to an agreement, the higher of the scores will be used. If both scorecards have been signed, then the lower of the two scores will be taken.
22. Each group will decide 2 shooters to keep score. Be certain all score boxes are filled in.
23. Upon completion of the round, all score cards are to be signed by both scorekeepers along with the shooter, (i.e.: three signatures are required on the bottom of the card).
24. Each individual is responsible for turning in both of their score cards, whether complete or not, within 30 minutes of the completion of the round. If no score is turned in, the contestant will be disqualified. In cases of discrepancies between two score cards, the lower score will be used.
25. All tie scores will first be broken by total cumulative X count over 2 days. If still tied: Highest Day 1 score, then highest day 2 score, then first dropped point per end, then first dropped x per end. For 1st place in championship flight only, if still tied there will be a shoot-off immediately following the last line.
26. Your target assignment by the registration committee is final.
27. Pro Division for all NFAA Pros only.
28. Professionals from other organizations (ASA, IBO) are NOT required to shoot in the professional division.
29. All Equipment rules will follow NFAA Rules.
30. Equipment will be checked at random for compliance with NFAA rules. Anyone found shooting non-compliant equipment will be disqualified.
31. Lighted nocks are not allowed.
32. Any individual wishing to file a protest/grievance against another archer must inform a tournament official that a protest will be filed. Both individuals have the right to be present at the meeting of the Protest Committee. All protests must be submitted within 30 minutes after the end of the line on which the alleged offense occurred. All protests/grievances must be accompanied by a \$25 fee, which will be refunded if the protest/grievance is upheld. No protest that is filed after the time limit will be considered or acted on.
33. NFAA flight system will be used.
34. Professional payouts will be based on NFAA payback distribution charts
35. SMOKING is only permitted in designated areas outdoors.
36. No alcoholic beverages (or use of nonprescription, mood altering drugs) are allowed while participating in the tournament. Violators will be automatically disqualified. Anyone accused of being under the influence will be evaluated by the tournament committee.
37. Any abusive / offensive language or gestures (spoken, written, or on clothing) will not be tolerated and can result in disqualification based on the tournament committee ruling.

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**Day 2 - Vegas 300 Round**

1. A "NFAA Vegas 300 Round" will be shot. The round shall consist of 30 arrows, shot as two games, at a distance of 20 yards. Each game shall consist of 5 ends of 3 arrows per end. There will be 2 practice ends.
2. The target shall be either the "Vegas 3-spot" face or the "40 cm. Vegas" face.
3. Entrants may choose to shoot either the 40 cm. single-spot target or the 3-spot target. Competitors must use the same target face throughout the round.
4. Cubs will shoot at 10 yards.
5. Archers must switch from top to bottom, bottom to top after half. Bottom shoot first.
6. Time limit: Timing standards will be employed for the 2 minutes allowed per end. Note: No arrow may be drawn prior to the whistle or shot after the time runs out. Any arrow shot after the time has run out, the highest scoring arrow will be pulled and not scored.
7. Sky Drawing, or drawing the bow with the bow hand above the head is not allowed, one warning will be given, after one warning the archer will be disqualified.
8. No ear buds, headphones, or any ear coverings allowed on the shooting line.
9. Shooters will be called to the shooting line by a whistle. Do not approach the line prior to whistle.
10. Upon completion of each end, please step away from the shooting line exercising courtesy to the shooters on both sides of you.
11. All shooters will straddle the shooting line in a reasonably even fashion.
12. No one is allowed on the shooting floor except officials and archers shooting the line.
13. Equipment failure: An official should be summoned to handle the situation. The archer will have THREE ENDS without holding up the tournament. The archer shall be allowed to shoot any amount of arrows during the three ends on their own bale. Archer must score starting on end four, or sooner. All make-up arrows will be shot at the end of the round.
14. Any arrow propelled fully beyond the 10-foot foul line is considered a shot arrow.
15. If an archer shoots more than the prescribed number of arrows in an end, the excess arrow or arrows of higher value will not be scored. A penalty of one (1) point (and X if applicable) will be assessed for each arrow shot over the prescribed number of arrows.
16. An archer may shoot the 3-spot target in any order, and shoot as many arrows into any spot as the archer desires, not to exceed the prescribed number of arrows per end.
17. Witnessed bounce outs and pass through in the scoring area will be re-shot. Summon an official to handle the situation. Arrows hanging from the front or rear of the target butt must be handled by a tournament official. Do not touch the arrow!
18. No arrow may be touched prior to the completion of scoring all arrows in the butt.
19. Single spot face scoring: X-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1-0. 3-spot face scoring: X-10-9-8-7-6-0.

- X's for each end will be recorded. An arrow shaft needs only to touch the line to be counted in the area of the next higher value.
20. Each group will elect a target captain who will call the scores of all arrows on their target butt. Any discrepancies or questionable arrows must be handled by an official.
  21. If the score cards reflect a difference in score per end PRIOR to archer signature, and the group cannot come to an agreement, the higher of the scores will be used. If both scorecards have been signed, then the lower of the two scores will be taken.
  22. Each group will decide 2 shooters to keep score. Be certain all score boxes are filled in.
  23. Upon completion of the round, all score cards are to be signed by both scorekeepers along with the shooter, (i.e.: three signatures are required on the bottom of the card).
  24. Each individual is responsible for turning in both of their score cards, whether complete or not, within 30 minutes of the completion of the round. If no score is turned in, the contestant will be disqualified. In cases of discrepancies between two score cards, the lower score will be used.
  25. All tie scores will first be broken by total cumulative X count over 2 days. If still tied: Highest Day 1 score, then highest day 2 score, then first dropped point per end, then first dropped x per end. For 1st place in championship flight only, if still tied there will be a shoot-off immediately following the last line.
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  33. NFAA flight system will be used.
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  35. SMOKING is only permitted in designated areas outdoors.
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  37. Any abusive / offensive language or gestures (spoken, written, or on clothing) will not be tolerated and can result in disqualification based on the tournament committee ruling.
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**2026 NYFAB Range Of The Year Shootoff**  
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**Vegas 3 Spot Target**

1. Teams will consist of the 3 highest scoring archers from each NYFAB Range that had at least 3 competitors in the 2026 NYFAB Indoor League, AND are registered for the State Championship
  - a. If an archer within the top 3 of the range is not present at the State Championship, the next lowest is able to be on the team.
  
2. Round to be shot:
  - a. 2 Practice ends
  - b. 3 ends on a Vegas Face
    - i. Each end will consist of 1 arrow from each archer into one target face, scored cumulatively.
    - ii. Archers will rotate through all three archers, each end
    - iii. X's will be scored as 11's
    - iv. Timing will be 2 minutes per end, for all 3 archers to shoot, any arrow fired after the clock reaches 0 will be a zero.
    - v. The first archer may be on the shooting line when the clock begins
    - vi. No time allowance will be given for equipment failure, if an archer cannot continue their team is eliminated.
  
3. Tie Breakers, First place ONLY
  - a. If the first place score has a total cumulative tied score the tie breakers will be as follows:
    - i. One more end will be shot, the closest to center of the x, of any member of the team will decide the winning team.
  
4. Award:
  - a. The winning Range will be presented with a check for \$480 (\$5 from each NYFAB Indoor League Registration)
  - b. Each Archer on the winning range team will be presented with a \$100 check

## DAY 1 Announcements

### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE FIRST

- *You will be shooting a 5 spot or a single spot target, you may not switch target face styles once scoring begins, but you may replace your target face at any time*
- Archers must switch from top to bottom, bottom to top after half. Bottom shoot first
- Time per end is 4 minutes
- No arrow may be drawn prior to the whistle or shot after the time runs out.
- Sky Drawing is not allowed, 1 warning will be given, after that the archer will be disqualified.
- No ear buds or headphones allowed on the shooting line.
- Any arrow propelled fully beyond the 10-foot foul line is considered a shot arrow.
- Equipment failures must contact an official immediately, you will have 3 ends to repair anything
- Never shoot more than 5 arrows per end
- Witnessed bounce outs and pass throughs will be re-shot at the end of the round
- At halfway we will switch top to bottom, and bottom to top
- Bottom shooters will always shoot first
- First two ends will be practice
- Shooters will be called to the shooting line with two whistles.
- Shooting will begin with one whistle
- Retrieve arrows with 3 whistles

### END of ROUND

- You have now completed your day 1 score
- Scores will be posted on facebook and our website by 9pm tonight
- All score cards must be turned in 30 minutes from now here at the DOS stand
- **IF MAKEUP ARROWS:** We have makeup arrows, please return behind the line as quickly as possible

## DAY 2 Announcements

### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE FIRST

- *You will be shooting a 3 spot or a single spot target, you may not switch target face styles once scoring begins, but you may replace your target face at any time*
- Archers must switch from top to bottom, bottom to top after half. Bottom shoot first
- Time per end is 2 minutes
- No arrow may be drawn prior to the whistle or shot after the time runs out.
- Sky Drawing is not allowed, 1 warning will be given, after that the archer will be disqualified.
- No ear buds or headphones allowed on the shooting line.
- Any arrow propelled fully beyond the 10-foot foul line is considered a shot arrow.
- Equipment failures must contact an official immediately, you will have 3 ends to repair anything
- Never shoot more than 3 arrows per end
- Witnessed bounce outs and pass throughs will be re-shot at the end of the round
- At halfway we will switch top to bottom, and bottom to top
- Bottom shooters will always shoot first
- First two ends will be practice
- Shooters will be called to the shooting line with two whistles.
- Shooting will begin with one whistle
- Retrieve arrows with 3 whistles

### END of ROUND

- You have now completed the State Championship Round
- Awards will be presented 45 minutes after the completion of the afternoon line.
- All score cards must be turned in 30 minutes from now here at the DOS stand
