

New NYFAB Field Archery (International Round) Triple Crown Round Rules

To be eligible to be a Field Triple Crown Champion you MUST shoot 2 qualifying score PLUS the Final (State Championship). Archers who shoot more than 2 qualifiers may drop the lowest scores. Combination of the 2 qualifying PLUS the Finals score will determine the triple crown champion.

- ALL NFAA divisions will be offered
 - This must be done in order to have the State Championship as the final leg.
- NYFAB will offer a “Novice” class for those who are new to field and do not want to shoot full distances, they will shoot from the Youth stakes (max 50yd). This class will NOT get a NFAA State Championship plaque, only eligible for triple crown award.
 - There will be a “Male Novice” and “Female Novice” offered, no equipment specific division.
- Archers who are not NYFAB members can compete, but will pay \$5 more per entry fee
- Medals or pins will be given for each qualifying leg, it will be the responsibility of the host club to distribute awards.
 - Results will be posted on Facebook and the website within days.
- The top 2 qualifying scores and Finals score will be part of the NYFAB Shooter of the Year program, same as the hit/miss was.

General Rules:

1. 3 Arrows per target scored as a normal Field round (5,4,3)
2. Two 10 target halves (60 arrows total)
 - a. Yardages: 20,25,30,35,40,45,50,55,60,65
3. Only the “Hunter” face is used
4. 3 let downs allowed per arrow
5. X’s will be counted for tie breakers (Pro’s do not score x as a 6)
6. Target face sizes: 20-30yd: 35cm (Must have 4 target faces per bale), 35-50yd: 50cm (One target face per bale minimum), 55-65yd: 65cm (One target face per bale)
7. Archers will change top/bottom AND left/right at half

NYFAB Chartered clubs can host the round on a traditional field course range, OR on their practice range. See description below:

Field Range Option: Two 10 target halves consisting of the following yardages:

- Adult, Young Adult, Seniors: 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65
- Youth, Novice: 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 50, 50, 50
- Cub: 10, 10, 10, 15, 18, 20, 20, 20, 25, 30
- At target 11 (half) archers will change top/bottom and left/right (an archer on the bottom right will now be top left)

*These yardages may be shot in any order per half

* Club only needs 10 targets to hold qualifying shoot

Practice Range Option: Archers must all shoot from one line, bags must be able to move to accommodate cub and youth distances.

- Archers will shoot 2 ends at each distance to complete the full round.
- Archers will start at 20 yards and finish at 65 yards.
- 2 ends at 20, 2 ends at 25, 2 ends at 30, 2 ends at 35, etc. out to 65
 - See cub/youth distances above
- Archers will change the target faces when they get to 35 yards and 55 yards
 - At half-way archers will change top to bottom, and right to left (an archer on the bottom right will now be top left). This will happen on the first end of 45 yards

New NYFAB Field Archery (International Round) Triple Crown Bid/Host Rules

1. Host Club must be a NYFAB chartered club by Bid due date. Ranges must be inspected prior to event.
 - a. Bid sheet must be postmarked by December 31. (see attached bid sheet)
2. Clubs may only host two qualifiers maximum, UNLESS no other club within 2 hours is hosting another qualifier (determined by google maps), Club may host 3 qualifiers if that is the case
3. Clubs within 2 hours of each other may not overlap shoot weekends
 - a. If 2 clubs wish to host on the same weekend, the Board will choose at random (out of a hat etc.)
4. Round can be shot on an existing field course, or on a practice range if no course is available. See attached rule sheet for details
5. Club will be responsible for the following:
 - a. Club will run the shoot, no NYFAB representatives will be required to be on site
 - b. Registration / Fee collection
 - i. Club must mail appropriate money, via check, to NYFAB within 1 week
 - ii. NYFAB provided spreadsheet will calculate what fee is owed to NYFAB
 - c. Score collection
 - i. Put scores into spreadsheet provided by NYFAB
 - ii. Submitting completed spreadsheet to NYFAB within 3 days via email
 - iii. If clubs do not have any way to submit scores to NYFAB electronically in the provided spreadsheet, the club may not host the shoot.
 - d. Distribution of awards (provided by NYFAB) within a timely manner
6. NYFAB is responsible for the following:
 - a. Providing appropriate target faces to club representative
 - b. Providing PDF (printable) score cards – no hard copies
 - c. Providing PDF (printable) sign in sheet – no hard copies
 - d. Providing Excel spreadsheet for scores and accounting purposes (help will be provided if you have any questions)
 - i. Tutorial video will be available on how to fill out sheets
 - e. Posting results on facebook and website within one week
 - f. Provide Medals/pins to club
 - g. Awards at the final leg (State Championship) ONLY.
 - i. If winner is not present, award will be given to area director or home club representative for distribution. They will not be mailed.

FEES:

\$15 per event – Seniors, adult, young adult

- \$10 to club, \$5 to State

\$10 per event - NYFAB Youth and Cub (under 15)

- \$5 to club, \$5 to state
