Dear NYFAB Members-

We are coming to the end of the calendar year and nominations for possible induction into the NYFAB Hall of Fame must be submitted by December 31, 2020. Please consider NYFAB Members who may be eligible for this honor in either the competitive or administrative category. In order to be eligible the nominee must have a list of accomplishments in archery at the state level or above, whether that be by virtue of their having been a constant worker in administrative duties like NYFAB Board of Directors, workers at state (or above) tournaments and/or events or those who have won style championships at state level or above. We need your Club or Area to send of list of all these accomplishments with as many specifics as possible like: they won the Female Freestyle Indoor State Championship in 2012, 2013, and 2014 plus the national championship in 2015, etc. OR they have been an active member of the state board of directors during the years 1998 through 2008, served as President of NYFAB in 1997 and 1998 and served as tournament chairman for the outdoor state championship in 1999 and 2000. Please submit the most comprehensive listing of your nominee's accomplishments/resume along with a clear picture of the individual to me as soon as possible. If you need help coordinating it, don't hesitate to contact me. I'll be glad to help you get it ready by the December 31 deadline.

This past year the NYFAB Hall of Fame Committee also approved a "Second Honors" category for individuals who were previously inducted in one category (Admin or Comp) and have qualified for Hall of Fame Second Honors in the other. Eg- they have been inducted in the past in the Admin category, but also have a list of accomplishments for the Competition category. Again, we need these resumes submitted by the Dec. 31 deadline.

Voting for this year's inductee in the Administrative and/or Competition category will be done by the Hall of Fame Committee and winners will be announced at the 2021 Indoor Championship. Only one person can be inducted in each of these categories in any given year. Second Honors are not limited to one person, but will also be voted on by the Hall of Fame Committee by virtue of a Yes or No vote. The Chairman of the committee does not vote unless there is a tie.

Please consider getting a resume in for archers who have demonstrated exceptional dedication to administrative efforts or have been top competitor/champions over their archery career.
