FAIRVIEW ACRES - LATERAL WATER SHUT DOWN POLICY

Any request made to shut down FALWUA system requires the submittal of a written work plan, including a schedule of work to be done for approval by a majority of the Board. The Board meets on the third Tuesday of the month. The following fees will be assessed and must be paid upfront based on the number of days per season requested:

- For the first 3 days of shutoff: \$150 per day
- For each day exceeding 3 days: \$500 per day not to exceed 7 days.

Should time need to be extended past the seven-day requirement, further approval is required, and project may be subject to delay after regular water season.

Lateral Shut Down Form to be filled out and submitted prior to work commencing.

Include all plans, drawings, specifications, and timeline for work to be completed.

Any work completed prior to approval is subject to fines related to damages caused as a result of the water being off.
