Planning 18th – 29th January

Week 1:

18th – 22nd January

Theme – Jack and The Beanstalk

Following on from children's interest in the story Jack and the Beanstalk

Craft -

- Planting beans in plastic cups with a castle and cloud encourage discussion about what
 we will need for our bean to grow.
 - Sequencing storyboard of planting a bean

Circle Time -

Encourage children's attention and recall during story time Continue to learn our play/songs from our Jack and the Beanstalk story

Week 2:

25th – 29th January

Emphasis on supporting and encouraging children to improve fine motor skills, activities such as: threading, tweezers, tracing, cutting, dough gym, pencil control work sheets, drawing in sand, controlling objects with magnets

Craft -

Make our own bird feeders using pipe cleaners and cheerio's (linking in with our fine motor development activities)

Make bird houses using milk bottles

PSED

Enjoys responsibility of carrying out small tasks (30-50)

Keeps play going by responding to what others are saying or doing (30-50)

Can inhibit own actions/behaviours eg, stop themselves from doing something they shouldn't be doing (22-36)

Welcomes and values praise for what they have done (30-50)

CL

Uses gestures sometimes with limited talk (22-36)

Understand who, what, where in simple questions (22-36)

PD

Can catch a large ball (30-50)

Can copy some letters eg, letters from their name (30-50)

MD

Uses some number names accurately in play (30-50)

Shows awareness of similarities of shapes in the environment (30-50)

Uses positional language (22-36)

L

Listens to and joins in with stories one to one and in small groups (30-50)

Recognises familiar words and signs such as own name and logos (30-50)

Enjoys rhyming and rhythmic activities (30-50)
