#### PSED

Can express there own feelings such as sad, happy, cross, worried (22-36)
Can usually adapt behaviour to different events, social situations and changes in routine (30-50)

### CL

Identifies action words by pointing to the right picture (22-36)
Uses vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance to them (30-50)

Can retell a simple past event in the correct order (30-50)

### PD

Imitates drawing simple shapes such as lines/circles (22-36) Can copy some letters eg, letters from their name (30-50)

#### MD

Notices simple shapes and patterns in pictures (22-36)

Compares two groups of objects saying when they have the same number (30-50)

Sometimes matches numeral and quantity correctly (30-50)

Shows awareness of similarities of shapes In the environment (30-50)

#### Т

Sometimes gives meaning to marks as they draw and paint (30-50) Suggests how the story might end (30-50) Describes main story settings, events and principal characters (30-50)

#### UW

Enjoys playing with small world models such as farm, garage, train track (22-36) Developing an understanding of growth, decay and changes over time (30-50) Can talk about some things they have observed such as plants/animals (30-50)

### EAD

Beginning to construct, stacking blocks vertically, horizontally making enclosures and spaces (30-50)
