Resolving fall outs and solving problems

- 1. Approach calmly
- 2. Acknowledge feelings
- 3. Gather information
- 4. Re-state the problem
- 5. Ask for solutions and choose one together
- 6. Be prepared to give follow up support

Typically sources of disagreements are about toys, space /chairs, turns.

REMEMBER THAT YOUNG CHILDREN ARE:

Egocentric, only thinking about their own point of view

Concrete thinkers and can't always understand concepts like "you must share"

Naturally physical and this is how they express most feelings
