1. Approach calmly
2. Acknowledge feelings
3. Gather information
4. Re-state the problem
5. Ask for solutions and choose one together
6. Be prepared to give follow up support

Typically sources of disagreements are about toys,space /chairs,turns.

REMEMBER THAT YOUNG CHILDREN ARE:

Egocentric, only thinking about their own point of view

Concrete thinkers and can't always understand concepts like "you must share"

Naturally physical and this is how they express most feelings
