Community Partnerships

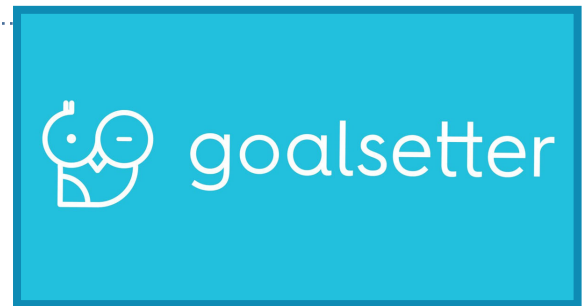
